### Goodland wrestler wins at tournament

Former Cowboy wrestler Blayze Bahe won the 125-pound class at the Old Chicago Northern Colorado Open held Nov. 21 in Greeley.

Bahe, a freshman at the University of Northern Colorado, won four straight matches, beating both top seeds along the way. In the first round Bahe, pinned Rad Lawver of Northwest College (Wash.) 50 seconds into the second period.

In the second round, Bahe faced Marques Bravo of Western State College of Gunnison, Colo., the No. 1 seed, winning a tough decision 1-0. Next he defeated Matt Torrez, another wrestler from Northwest College, in the semifinals 4-1.

In the title match, Bahe faced Anthony Cunha of Sierra College (Calif.), the No. 2 seed, winning a 6-0 decision. Bravo defeated Torrez for third place.

The Bears of Northern Colorado will be one of about 50 teams in action Friday and Saturday at the 23rd Annual Cliff Keen Invitational at

the Cashman Center in Las Vegas.

### Former Bulldog begins conference play Thursday

Alicia Collett, a sophomore at Sterling College, came off the bench to score three points and grab four rebounds Saturday during the Lady Warriors' 71-56 loss to Hastings College.

This is Collett's second year playing basketball for Sterling. As a freshman last season, she saw limited action in just three games.

Alicia, daughter of Scott and Alice Collett of Levant, is a 2003 graduate of Brewster High, where she lettered in volleyball and track as well as basketball.

The Warriors, 6-2 for the season, will begin play in the Kansas Collegiate Athletic Conference on Thursday at Ottawa University, which is now 2-5 after losing to William Jewell College (Mo.) last Tuesday 73-60.

Sterling was ranked No. 15 in the National Association of Intercolle-

giate Athletics' Division II pre-season poll. Hastings is No. 3.
