Cowgirls' first roundup tonight

The Cowgirls will be out to round up the Lady Longhorns from Chase County High School of Imperial, Neb., at 5:30 tonight in Max Jones Fieldhouse.
Goodland radio KLOE (730AM) will broadcast the game live, with the pregame show starting around 5:15 p.m.
Tuesday night, the team had its intrasquad scrimmage, giving every player except one got some time. Sophomore Amber Cowan has been ill and will rejoin the team when ready.
Coach Don Smith said the main thing he wanted from the scrimmage was the chance for the girls to play under game conditions with officials before facing their first opponent.
The players were divided into two teams, Black and Gold, to play

four eight-minute periods. The teams stayed with the initial line-up for the first three periods, playing even ball throughout most of that time.
Before starting the fourth quarter, Smith made changes to the line-up, putting the majority of the experience and strength on the Black team, which the score reflected. At the end of the fourth period, Smith made one final line-up change and had the teams play a "fifth quarter" with a continuous clock.
Smith said the scrimmage showed some things the players need to work on during practice on Wednesday and Thursday, noting that there was not a lot of time before tonight's season opener. He said during the scrimmage the team implemented some new pieces for its game plan, some of which did not go as smoothly as he would like.
Smith said one of the bright spots

was the way the players performed as a unit, being unselfish with the ball and continuously looking for the open player. He said the scrimmage was a chance for the girls to get over some of the jitters of playing not only with officials but in front of an audience.
This is Smith's first season as the girls basketball coach. Last season he was an assistant for the boys team. On the sidelines with Smith will be Curt Minner, of Western Insurance Agency, who helped coach junior high basketball the past two seasons.
The Cowgirls travel to Burlington on Tuesday. Their next home action will be at 6 p.m. on Thursday, the first day of the Topside Tip-Off tournament. The Goodland girls will face the Lady Coyotes of Weskan High School in Max Jones Fieldhouse.

Sagebrush Shootout starts Tuesday

Tip-off times for games starting after 3 p.m. will depend on the end of the previous game.
The tournament continues on Friday and concludes on Saturday, with the schedule based on the outcome of Tuesday's games.
