He said the players hustled throughout the game and played well once they settled down. He said he thought they played their best during the fourth period.

Leading 10-6 after the first period, Goodland outscored the Longhorns 17-12 to take a 27-18 lead at halftime. About two minutes into the third period, Lohr hit a basket to give the Cowboys their first 10point lead at 31-21. Goodland led after three, 43-31.
