

Cowboys take fourth place at tough tourney

The Cowboys finished fourth out of 26 teams and had two wrestlers take first place at the Basehor-Linwood tournament Friday and Saturday in far eastern Kansas.

The team will travel to Hays on Friday for a two-day tournament.

“We wrestled very well at this tournament,” Coach Randy Bahe said.

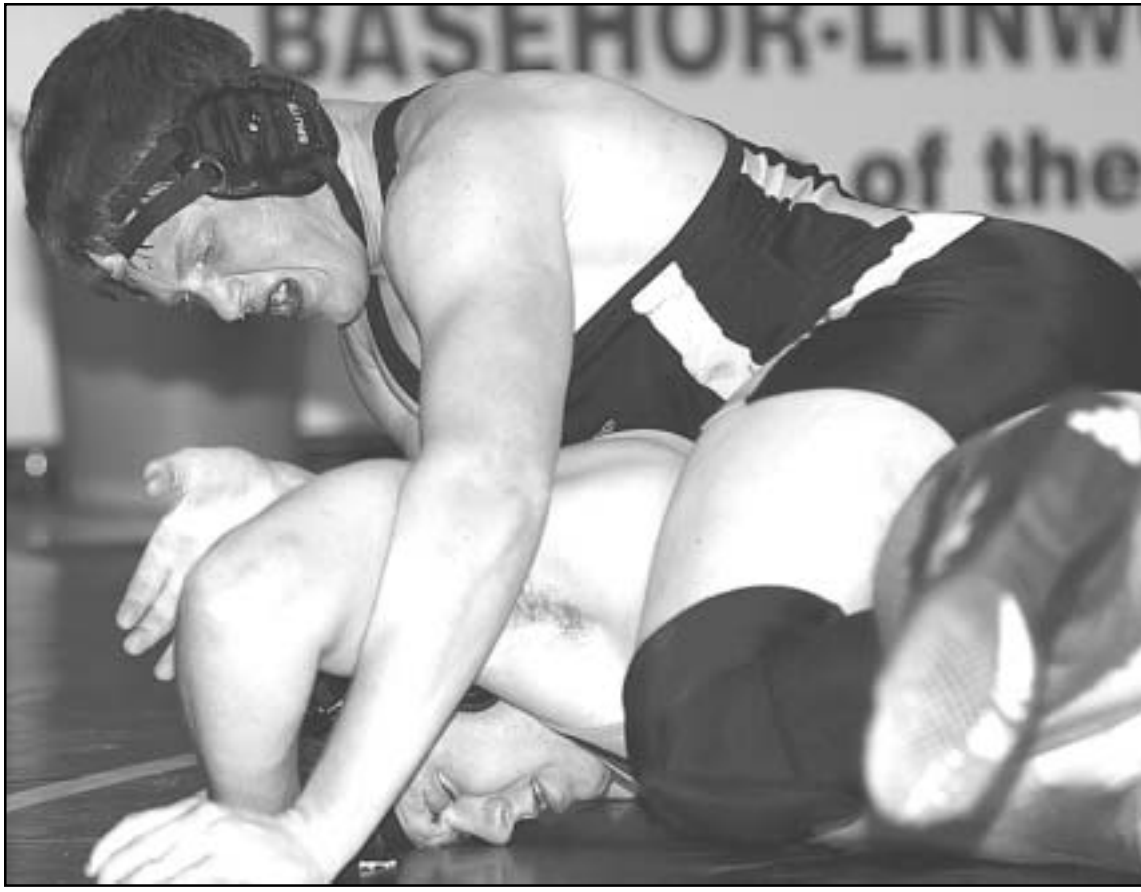
“This tournament is as tough or tougher than state, and with five starters out of the lineup, we did extremely well.

“We were only 10 points behind Abilene, who is ranked first in the state for 4A.”

Cowboys Brett Bahe and Mark Starr won their divisions. Dexter Deeds finished second, Jordan Albers was fifth and Jon Cook came in sixth.

The tournament was won by Turner High School of Kansas City, Kansas, with 171.5 points. Glenwood, Iowa, was second 166; Abilene third, 153.5; Goodland fourth, 143.5; Santa Fe Trail fifth, 138; and St. Thomas Aquinas sixth, 131.6. Individual results for the tournament:

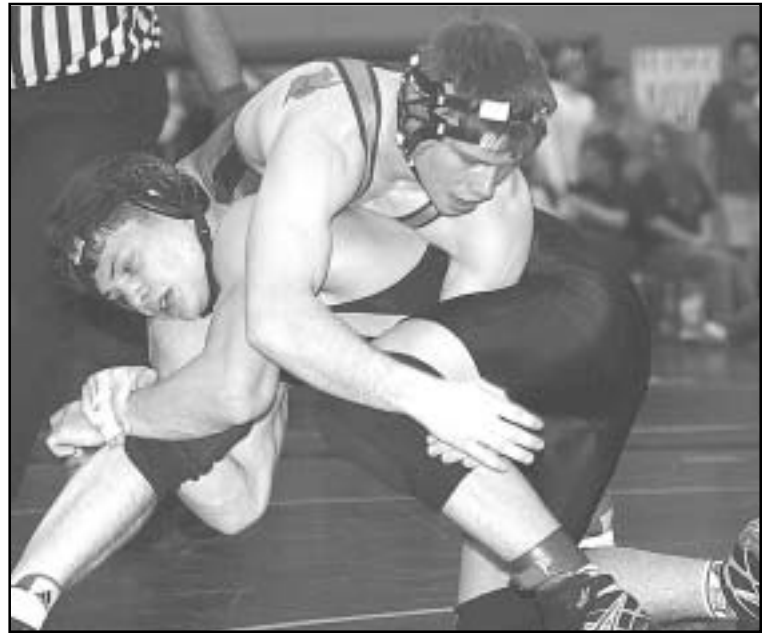

The Colby Community College women's basketball team lost to Seward County Community College Saturday in Liberal 62-48 as the Lady Trojans suffered their second straight loss and fell to 15-3 for the season.

The Lady Saints, ranked No. 3 by the National Junior College Athletic Association, led at halftime 22-17.

Seward County improved to 3-1 in the West Division of the Kansas Jayhawk Community College Conference while Colby fell to 2-2.

Freshman Rito Kollo led the Lady Trojans with 18 points. Freshman Ivana Mijalcevic scored nine points and sophomore Jill Mahoney scored eight.

Freshman Suzana Sormaz had six points, and sophomores Jayci Stone and Kelli Berg both scored three.

Freshmen Ivy Ramsey and Val Jackson both scored two points.

The Colby women suffered their second loss of the season last Wednesday at Great Bend against the Lady Cougars of Barton County Community College. The teams played even through the first 17 minutes of the game, but with the score tied at 22, Barton County went on a five-point run to lead at halftime 27-22.

The Cougars led throughout the second half, once by as much as 15 points, winning 64-56. Colby got to within two points, 52-50, with just

over three minutes left, but Barton County scored the next nine to secure the win.

Kollo led Colby with 15 points, followed by Mijalcevic with 12 and Sormaz with 10.

Freshman Shareka Purnell scored eight and Stojadinov seven. Stone and sophomore Jill Mahoney both scored two points.

On Jan. 9, the Lady Trojans defeated Cloud County Community College 95-74 in the Colby Community Building. Sormaz scored 25 points to lead Colby. Kollo scored 20, Stone 19 and Mijalcevic 11.

Two days earlier, Colby opened the year with a 76-59 over the Lady Broncbusters in Garden City.

Kollo led the Trojans with 16

points, followed by Stone with 15. Both Mijalcevic and Stujadinov had 12 points.

The Lady Dragons of No. 13-ranked Hutchinson Community College will be at the Colby Community Building on Wednesday to face Colby.

Tipoff will be 6 p.m. (Central Time). Hutchinson is 16-0 overall and 3-0 in the conference after defeating Cloud County Community College 57-44 on Saturday.
