

# Thirteen schools battle in Mustang Invitational

Max Jones Fieldhouse was transformed into a wrestling arena Saturday as the 2005 Mustang Invitational brought thirteen junior high teams to town.

Four large square mats filled the gym floor, allowing up to four pairs to match up for battle.

Cheering sections and teammates looked on as the athletes tried out new holds and won or lost points in each match.

Grant Junior High, Scott City, Kenneth Henderson from Garden City, Rawlins County from Atwood, Quinter, Kennedy Middle School from Hays, Burlington and Wray from Colorado, Felton from Hays, Kepley from Ulysses, Oakley, Hoxie and St. Francis all brought kids to the tournament.

Four Grant boys took first in their weight classes.

Goodland champions included Teather Dautel of Grant, who took home the win in the 93-pound championship bracket. Dautel beat S. McGuire from Scott City by pinning him after a minute.

Keegan Smith won in the 122-pound championship. Beating Anthony from Kepley, Smith won with a 4-0 decision.

Winning in the 250-pound bracket, Clay Schilling of Goodland beat A. Nieto of Kepley. Schilling pinned his man after 1.48 minutes.

Seven wrestlers took second in their weights.

Eduardo Martinez of Goodland won over J. Magana of Henderson in the 129-pound consolation bracket. Martinez pinned Magana after 2.49 minutes.

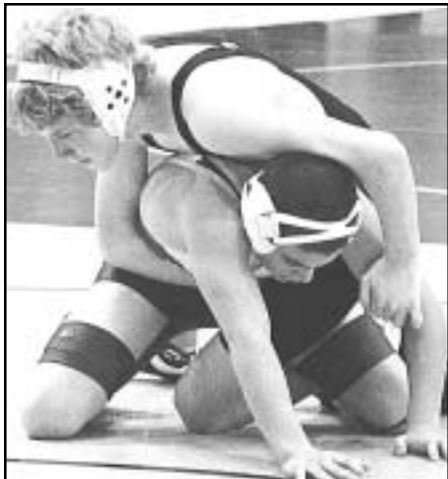
In the championship bracket at 79 pounds, Tyler McDonald lost to C. Wickham from Kenwood when he was pinned after 1 minute.

At Liberal, Laine Herl received the first-place medal at 130 pounds in the 10-and-under division, and Seth Miller took first at 72 pounds in the 12-and-under division.

Ian Bonsall was first at 110 pounds in the 8-and-under division at the Norton tournament.

In the 104 pound championship, Timothy Roeder of Goodland went up against D. Newell of Kepley. Newell won 6-0.

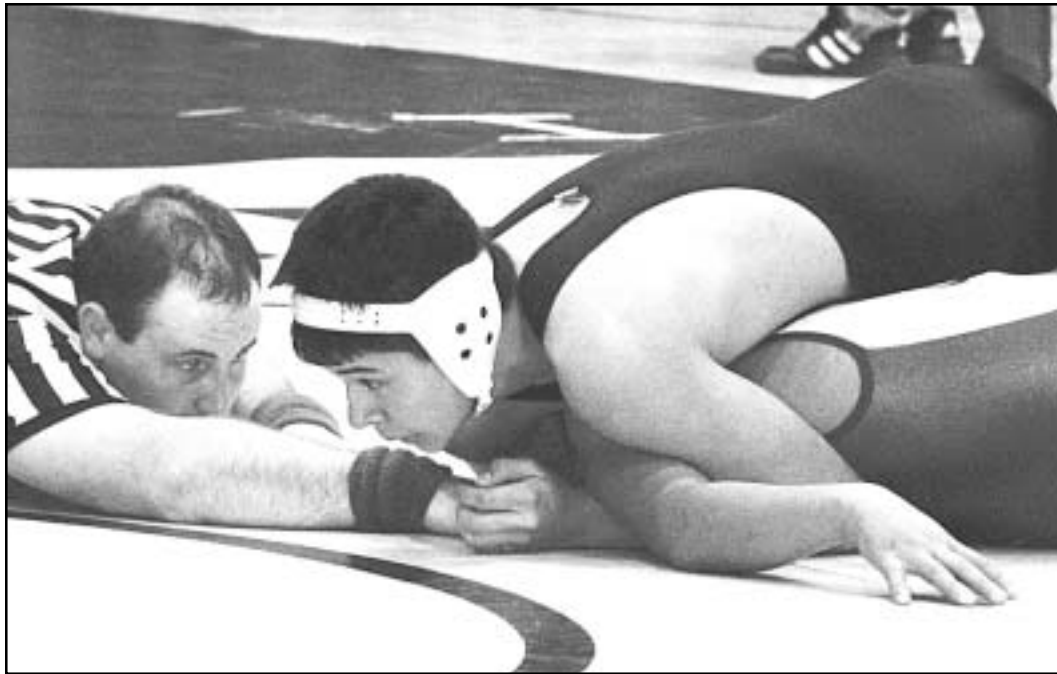
Ryan Taylor of Goodland took on C. Hoeme of Scott City in the 146-pound championship. Hoeme won with a pin after 50 seconds.

Fernando Martinez of Goodland lost to T. Hilt of St. Francis in the 170 pound championship bracket. Hilt got a 4 to 2 decision in his favor.

In the 110-pound consolation bracket, Bryan Gray beat L.

Winning in the consolation bracket for 116 pounds was Alberto Ruiz of Goodland. He beat C. Schamgerger from Hoxie by pinning him after 37 seconds.

The 122-pound consolation bracket was won by Gustavo Diaz of Goodland when he beat A. Vrbas of Rawlins County with a 5 to 6 decision.

Three Goodland boys took fourth.

In the consolation bracket Eric Whalen of Goodland took on C. Lovata of Burlington at 99 pounds. Lovata pinned Whalen after one minute.

Josh Lamb of Goodland went up against G. Lerma of Burlington in the 131 pound consolation bracket. Lerma beat Lamb with a pin after 21 seconds.

In the 182 pound consolation bracket, Jay Cotter of Goodland fell to P. Campbell of Wray. Campbell won a decision of 2 to 6.

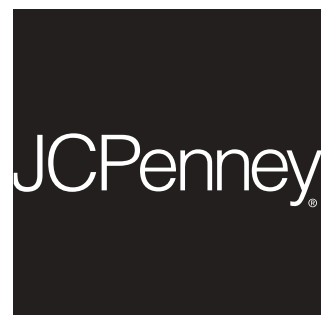
