The Goodland Star-News The Cowgirls routed the Lady Indians of St. Francis 60-25 in a Northwest Kansas League game Friday at Max Jones Fieldhouse, running their season record to 13-

The Goodland girls, a perfect 5-0 in league play, travel to Oakley on Friday, then a week later face Hoxie in a home game to end the regular season.

Goodland led from tipoff to buzzer on Friday, with the Indians getting no closer than eights points. The Cowgirls' "defensive intensity" held St. Francis to four points in the first quarter and five in the second. Goodland's dominance continued in the second half, as the Indians scored only 10 points in the third quarter and six in the fourth.

"Everyone got to play," said coach Don Smith. "We had a better balance of scoring between the perimeter game and the inside game. The team had a good shooting percentage in both halves."

The Cowgirls kept St. Francis scoreless for nearly the first five minutes, building a 10-0 lead before Megan Rice scored the first basket for the Indians. Goodland scored eight of the next 10 points to lead 18-4 going into the second period.

The Cowgirls went on a six-point run to start the second quarter, making the score 24-4. Then both teams entered a scoring drought for nearly three minutes until a basket by sophomore Lindsay Schields ended the slump. This time, the Goodland defense held the Indians scoreless for over five minutes until a pair of free throws by Amy Grace made it 26-6.

Goodland led 32-9 at halftime. Grace connected on another pair of free throws to start the scoring in the third period. After a basket by Goodland sophomore Dani Bedore, Grace scored her first field goal of the game to make it 34-13. The Cowgirls next went on a nine-point run, after which they outscored St. Francis 8-6 for a 51-19 lead going into the final period.

By league rules, when one team has at least a 30-point lead going into the fourth period, a continuous clock is used except for timeouts.
