The Cowboys wrestling team won its final dual meet of the season last Friday, beating the Oakley Plainsmen 37-26 in Max Jones Fieldhouse.

Both teams won seven matches but Goodland had five pins and Oakley none, which helped the Cowboys outscore Oakley by 11 points.

Coach Randy Bahe said he was pleased with how the team wrestled, especially since injuries forced a couple of lineup changes and a forfeiture.

The Plainsmen took the first lead of the meet, 4-0, when Steve Samuelson won a 12-0 major decision over Goodland freshman Allen Normandin at 103 pounds.

Sophomore Brett Bahe tied the meet at 4 with a 9-1 major decision over Mark Samuelson at 112 pounds. Sophomore Kerek Mason gave the Cowboys a 10-4 lead when he pinned Caleb Baalman with 15 seconds left in the first period of their 119-pound match.

FreshmanA.J. Stephens increased Goodland's lead to 16-4 with firstperiod pin of D.J. Reit-check at 125 pounds.

Sophomore Drake Moore of Oakley won a 3-0 decision over freshman Aaron Deeds at 130 pounds to make the team score 16-

Oakley's Levi Younkin, the topranked wrestler in Class 4A at 135 pounds, defeated senior Dexter Deeds by a 7-4 decision. The two wrestlers faced each other in the championship match at the Northwest Kansas League tournament on Jan. 29, with Younkin winning a 3-2 decision.

Kelly Younkin followed his older brother with a 3-2 decision over sophomore Brett Schields at 140 pounds, narrowing Goodland's lead to 16-13.

Oakley took a 19-16 lead when the Cowboys forfeited at 145 pounds. Goodland regained the lead for good when junior Brandon Hatfield Chase Reitcheck at 152 pounds, making the score 22-19.

Sophomore Jon Cook increased the Cowboys' lead to 28-19 also with a second-period fall over Oakley's Cole Habeib at 160 pounds.
