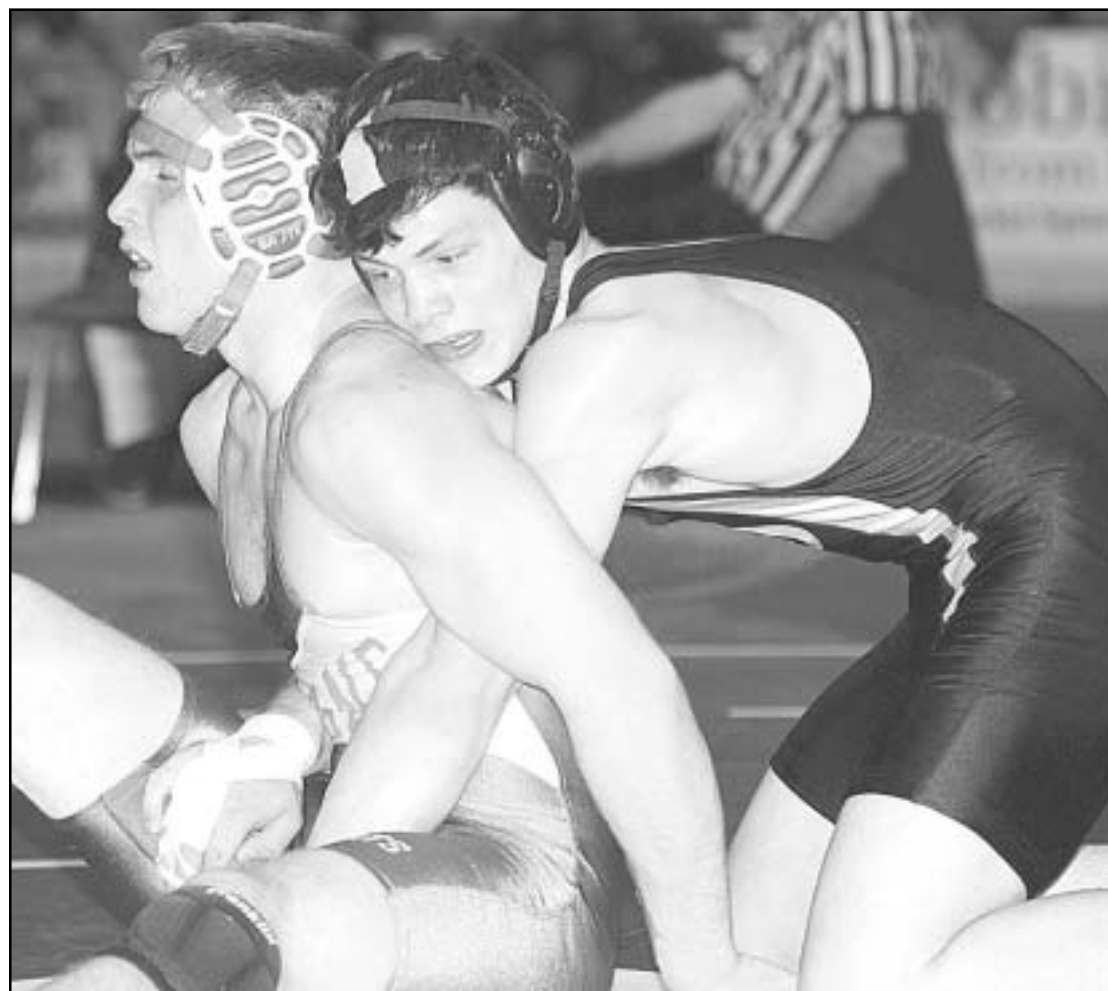


Cowboys wrestle into third place

Wrestlers win medals in Wichita



Sophomore Brett Bahe (on top in top photo) maintained the advantage Saturday through most of his title match at 112 pounds with Dustin Dooley of Concordia at the state wrestling tournament in Wichita. Bahe won a 7-2 decision for the gold medal. Sophomore Jon Cook (on right in above photo) dominated J.D. Hansen of Mulvane, pinning him in the second period of their 160-pound match. Senior Chad Normandin (on top in left photo) won a 7-0 decision over Colby's Daniel Tibbles in the fourth round of the consolation bracket, earning a spot in the third-place match at 103 pounds. There Normandin defeated Cale Demel of Eudora by a 7-1 decision for the bronze. Sophomore Kerek Mason (right in below photo) lost a 15-3 major decision to Kevin Callahan of Baldwin in the first round. Mason won his first match in the consolation bracket by default, then lost to Colby's Hunter Olsen by a first-period fall.
