

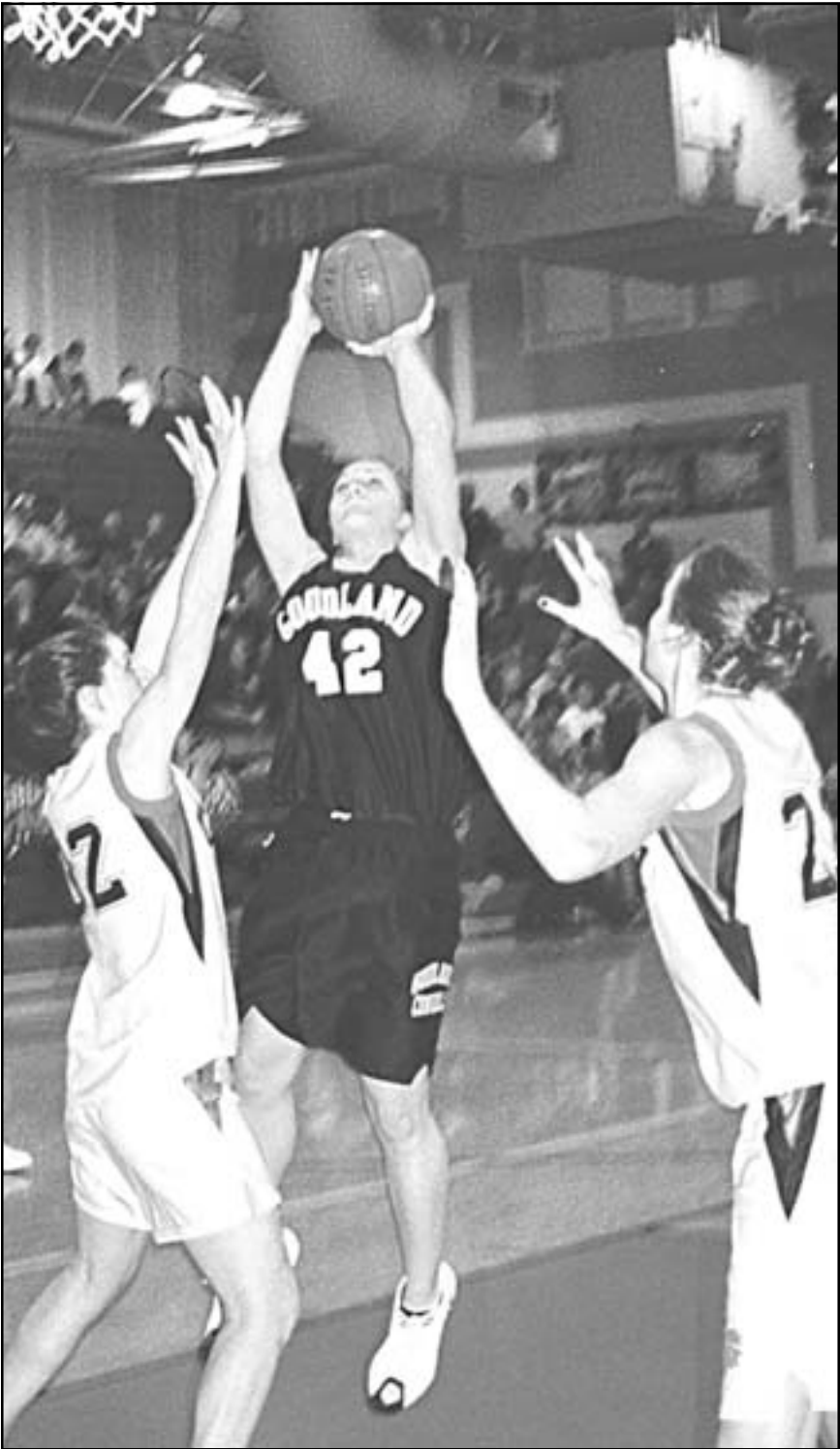


Substate action

Trojan softball team starts slow

The Colby Community College softball team finished 1-4 at the Cloud County Spring Classic this weekend in Concordia.

The Lady Trojans lost all three of their games on Saturday, won their first game Sunday, then lost the second. Colby is now 2-11 for the season.

The Trojans began the tournament with a 6-3 loss to Brown Mackie College. Freshman Danielle Schmidt was 2-for-3 at the plate, driving in a run. Colby lost its second game to Kansas Wesleyan University 5-1, then was shut out 8-0 by Cloud County Community

College.

The Trojans started Sunday with a 8-7 win over Hesston College. Schmidt again was the leading hitter, going 3-for-3 and driving in two runs. In its final game of the weekend, Colby fell 9-7 to Iowa Western Community College despite an 11-hit performance by the Trojans.

"On Sunday, we started to hit the ball and play defense," said coach Carl Adams. "We are starting to put it together. If we come out and play hard like we did the last game of the tournament, we will start winning games."

The Lady Trojans got off to a

rough start, posting a 1-7 record in the season's first 10 days.

Colby opened its season on Feb. 20, losing a doubleheader to the Lady Rattlers of Otero Junior College, 9-1 and 10-0, in La Junta, Colo. Four days later, Colby split a doubleheader with McCook Community College, losing the first game 3-1 and winning the second 14-5.

On Feb. 27, Colby lost a pair of games to Hutchinson Community College — both by one run. The Lady Dragons won the first game 7-6 and the second 8-7.

In the first game, freshmen Jessica Carlson and Heather Ebert both were 2-for-4 at the plate to Colby. In the second, sophomore Shanae Calkins, a 2003 Goodland High graduate, got four hits, driving in a run. In that same game, Ebert went 3-for-5 including a grand slam.

Last Tuesday the Trojans lost two home games, 9-1 and 4-2, to the Lady Conquistadors of Dodge City Community College.

In the first game, Dodge City pounded the Lady Trojans with 10 hits, scoring nine runs. Freshman Molly Langerak was Colby's leading batter, getting two hits in three trips to the plate and scoring the Trojans' only run.

In the second game, Colby scored only two runs on seven hits while the Conquistadors needed just four hits to score four runs to sweep the twin bill. Freshman Jessica Carlson went 3-for-3 at the plate, including a double and a triple, and drove in a run.

"I have been proud of the attitude of the players so far since we have been struggling," Adams said. "They have remained positive and pulling for each other."

The Lady Trojans will be in action again on Thursday in a doubleheader against Butler County Community College in El Dorado. On Friday they will be visiting Independence Community College for a doubleheader against the Lady Pirates.
