

God's kingdom rules over Earth, to bring his will

When Jesus was on earth, he taught his followers to pray for God's kingdom to come and God's will to be done on earth.

Matthew 6:9, 10 says, "You must pray, then, this way: 'Our Father in the heavens, let your name be sanctified. Let your kingdom come. Let your will take place, as in heaven, also upon earth.'"

In this case, God's kingdom will have a king, Jesus Christ, who will rule over earth. Hence, God's will will take place on earth.

Luke 1:30-33 says, "So the angel said to her: 'Have no fear, Mary, for you have found favor with God; and, look! you will conceive in your womb and give birth to a son, and you are to call his name Jesus. This one will be great and will be called Son of the Most High; and God will give him the throne of David his fa-

ther, and he will rule as king over the house of Jacob forever, and there will be no end to his kingdom.'"

When Jesus was on earth, he healed the sick, raised the dead, miraculously fed thousands of people with little food and taught about God's will. These things show what he can do for Earth. But he did not become king as soon as he ascended to heaven.

Hebrews 10:12, 13 says, "But this man offered one sacrifice for sins perpetually and sat down at the right hand of God, from then on awaiting

until his enemies should be placed as a stool for his feet."

Jesus would not rule alone. Luke 22:28-30 says, "However, you are the ones that have stuck with me in my trials; and I make a covenant with you, just as my Father has made a covenant with me for a kingdom, that you may eat and drink at my table in my kingdom, and sit on thrones to judge the twelve tribes of Israel."

Revelation 5:9, 10 says, "And they sing a new song, saying: 'You are worthy to take the scroll and open its seals, because you were slaughtered and with your blood you bought persons for God out of every tribe and tongue and people and nation, and you made them to be a kingdom and

priests to our God, and they are to rule as kings over the earth.'"

At Luke 12:32, Jesus called those future rulers a "little flock." Revelation 14:1-3 says there will be 144,000 rulers with Jesus in the kingdom.

Revelation 12:9, 12 foretold what would happen when Jesus takes the throne: "So down the great dragon was hurled, the original serpent, the one called Devil and Satan, who is misleading the entire inhabited earth; he was hurled down to the earth, and his angels were hurled down with him. On this account be glad, you heavens and you who reside in them! Woe for the earth and for the sea, because the Devil is coming down to you, having great anger, knowing he has a short period of time."

When Jesus became king of

God's kingdom, the immediate results were woe, turbulent times, as Satan was cast out of heaven and could then concentrate his full efforts on the earth.

Matthew chapter 24 foretells conditions described as "the last days." Verses 3, 7, 8 and 12 say, "While he (Jesus) was sitting upon the Mount of Olives, the disciples approached him privately, saying: 'Tell us, when will these things be, and what will be the sign of your presence and of the conclusion of the system of things?' 'For nation will rise against nation and kingdom against kingdom, and there will be food shortages and earthquakes in one place after another. All these things are a beginning of pangs of distress. . . and because of the increasing of lawlessness the love of the greater number will cool off.'"

These things are an indication that Jesus has taken the throne as king of God's kingdom. These being the

"last days" indicates that this is temporary; Jesus will bring better conditions under his rulership.

Matthew 25:31-34 says, "When the Son of man arrives in his glory, and all the angels with him, then he will sit down on his glorious throne. And all the nations will be gathered before him, and he will separate people one from another, just as a shepherd separates the sheep from the goats."

Verse 34 says the ones on his right hand will inherit the kingdom; verse 46 says the others will "depart into everlasting cutting-off. . . ."

Jesus said at John 10:27, "My sheep listen to my voice, and I know them, and they follow me."

At Matthew 24:14, he said, "And this good news of the kingdom will be preached in all the inhabited earth for a witness to all the nations; and then the end will come."

Now is the time for us to decide whether to listen or not.
