peared, but she sent a letter dated March 3 and addressed from Denver to her other son, David, 15, who lives with his father and stepmother. His mother asked about Marco and how he was doing, Ornelas said. Why would she do that if she had seen him?

Ornelas said she has been with Marco Ault Sr. six years, and the couple moved from Denver to Goodland in September 2003.

Denver but later wanted to leave his life there.

and he came to Goodland on a Greyhound nearly a year ago.

After he disappeared, Ornelas said, they called his friends in Den-Amanda, 18, and her husband in Las dropped him along the road some-Vegas. He hasn't been in touch with anyone, Ornelas said.

Tammy Freeman, former site coordinator at the learning center, said she worked with Marco for a short time before she left the job in May. He wasn't there that often, she said, and didn't seem that interested in getting his diploma.

"I don't know if he's changed," she said.

His father is on the house staff at Golden West Community Services, and Ornelas works at the Goodland Churches Thrift Store and is a secretary at Jones Land Co.
