

Session expected to adjourn for year by Saturday

Monday and Tuesday, only legislators involved with conference committee reports were required to be in Topeka.

About half of the legislators were home, but after the rest will be debating the compromises made in the conferences.

Wednesday, Thursday and Friday, the full legislature will be in session to vote without debate or amendments on the compromises reached in the conference committees. If a conference report is rejected, it remains in conference or is killed.

Sometimes conference committees cannot come to agreement, so an "agree to disagree" may be signed which allows four of the six members to prepare the report and present the compromise legislation to the chambers for an up or down vote.

Adjournment will be sometime Friday or possibly on Saturday. The full Legislature will not return until late April for the "wrap up" session expected to last four days.

The wrap up is supposed to be the Omnibus Reconciliation Bill only (finalize the budget based on governor's vetoes, etc.) and no new legislation is generally allowed. However, we can and have in the past changed the rules to conduct business on new or old legislation. That may happen this year depending on what happens with the Education Finance Bill.

One last thing — the Home Owned Carnival Legislation passed as one of the last bills on the last day to consider bills. It should be possible to obtain insurance coverage at the home carnivals now for less than has been required.
