

Volunteers haul tree limbs, furniture, trash and more

More than 20 tons lugged out

A smaller crew gathered Saturday morning to tackle the second round of the citywide clean up being guided by the Chamber of Commerce Beautification Committee.

Despite their smaller numbers, the volunteers collected as much or more than the 20 tons of trash and limbs hauled away in the first round on Saturday, April 2.

Ken Clouse, head of the beautification committee and president of Northwest Kansas Technical College, said 40 volunteers helped Saturday.

The city had three trucks and drivers, plus a county truck and loader which were kept busy with tree branches.

Rich Simon, superintendent of public works, said the city trucks each made eight trips and the county made 10 trips to the transfer station with limbs. He said there were two large loads of concrete and brick, and two of furniture and one of mattresses.

Weather for the second round was nearly as perfect as the first, but

there was more of a breeze. Planners decided that instead of burning branches on an open lot — as was done with the first round — they would all be hauled to the burn pit at the transfer station.

Alex West of Alex's Radiator and Repair hauled away a large pile of metal, which included many small items, a bicycle, lots of exercise equipment and the largest item of

the day, an old Kentucky Fried Chicken sign.

The volunteers were treated to hamburgers and drinks donated by Courtney Warden, Christie Rasure and Clouse at the end of the morning.

Out at the transfer station, Commissioner Mitch Tiede helped Margaret Russell and her workers as the line of vehicles sometimes reached

out to the county road.

Two of the last trucks which arrived at the station about 2 p.m. had a load of furniture and a load of mattresses.

Tiede and the city crew helped stack the mattresses on piles from the previous clean up. The county now has over 100 mattresses and box springs to handle.

Russell said the mattresses are a

problem because of the metal springs, and she is working on a way to separate the metal to save space in the landfill. The box springs are a bit easier to tear down, but like the furniture, it takes time to tear out the metal and wood.

With the great weather, city residents took advantage of free dumping and brought pickup and trailer loads to the transfer station. Most of

what was brought was tree limbs and grass clippings, but there was an assortment of metal and trash.

Clean up Month will conclude Saturday, with volunteers gathering at 8 a.m. at the student union at the technical college.

Clouse said they will view a video and then assign people to routes. Volunteers are encouraged to bring gloves.
