

# Cowboy clears 6’ for first

The Cowboys track and field team finished fifth and the Cowgirls sixth at the 70th annual Scott City Invitational last Tuesday.

Senior Lane Winter led the Goodland boys, placing first in the high jump at 6 feet, and second in the 100-meter dash. He also ran the 200-meter dash.

Senior Bret Jarmin placed third in the javelin and fourth in the 100-meter dash. Senior Drew Wilkens finished third in the 300-meter intermediate hurdles and sophomore Kerek Mason was third in the 1,600-meter run.

Sophomore Troy Harrison placed third in the high jump, and also ran the 400-meter dash, triple jump and javelin. Senior Wade Taylor finished fourth in the 400-meter dash and fifth in the triple jump. Senior Anthony Benavides finished fifth in the 400-meter dash.

Freshman Casey Henderson ran the 100 and 200-meter dashes, and threw the shot. Freshmen Robert Doxon and Jason Krayca both threw the discus and shot. Sophomore Nathan Thomas also threw the discus for the Cowboys.

Freshman Dustin Pennington was in the 800-meter and 1,600-meter runs. Freshman Toby Hurst ran the 1,600 and 3,200-meter races. Freshman Brett Meissinger was in the 200-meter dash and the javelin.

Junior Jared Robinson was in the pole vault, clearing 9 feet, along with Hurst who cleared 8 feet 6 inches.

The 4x100-meter relay team of Winter, Jarmin, Taylor and Henderson placed third. The 4x400 team of Wilkens, Benavides, Taylor and Mason came in fourth.

The Tigers of Ulysses High won the boys team competition with 122 points. Hugoton was second with 93, Scott City third with 83 and Larned fourth with 79. Goodland scored 64. Lakin was sixth with 56 points, followed by Colby just one point behind.

For the Cowgirls, sophomore Emily Murray placed second in the 300-meter hurdles and fourth in the 100-meter hurdles. Senior Kara Angelos was third in the 100-meter hurdles and fourth in the 300.

Sophomore Stephanie Sheldon cleared 7 feet 6 inches to place second in the pole vault. She also ran the 100-meter dash. Junior Lisha Tedford finished fourth in both the shot put and discus.

Sophomore Kaylee Billinger placed third in the 100-meter dash. Junior Tiffany Thomas finished fourth in the 3,200-meter run and sixth in the 1,600 meters.

Other Cowgirls competing in Scott City were senior Whitney Carmichael in the 100-meter dash; junior Kali Rietcheck in the 400-meter dash; sophomore Emily Linden in the 200 and 400-meter dashes; sophomore Whitney Dautel in the 800 and 1,600-meter runs; freshman Halli Stone in the 800-meter run and javelin; and freshman Heidi Yonkey in the long jump.

The Cowgirls' 4x100-meter relay team of Carmichael, Angelos, Murray and Billinger placed third, and the 4x400 team of Rietcheck, Linden, Murray and Billinger sixth.

The Lady Eagles of Colby came out on top with 115.5 points, followed by Scott City with 111. Larned was third with 90 points, Lakin fourth with 88.5 and Hugoton fifth with 59.5. Goodland's score was 54. Ulysses was seventh, scoring 32.5.

Goodland will be the host for the Tri-State Relays on Friday. Schools expected to participate include Colby, Scott City and Ulysses.



## Cowboys lose to Dodge City, face Holcomb on Thursday

Senior pitcher Brock Lohr (left photo) delivered a strike to a batter from Dodge City last Tuesday. The Cowboys took a 6-0 lead over the Red Demons in the top of the second inning but Dodge City came back to tie the game in the bottom of the fourth. Both teams scored a run each in the fifth and sixth innings. The scored was tied at eight after seven, forcing an extra inning, with the Red Demons scoring in the bottom of the eighth for a 9-8 win. In Goodland's game against Manhattan on Tuesday in Dodge City, junior Derek Fenner (above) just missed tagging an Indian runner at third base. Manhattan took a 10-0 lead in the first, increasing it to 11-0 by the fifth inning for the win. The Cowboys are now 3-6 for the season. Goodland will play a home doubleheader against Holcomb at 3 p.m. on Thursday.

## Colby coach takes Garden City job

John Woods started work as coach of the Colby Community College men's basketball team on April 15, just two days after Brian Marso resigned to take the coaching job at Garden City Community College.

Woods was Marso's assistant this season, helping to lead the Trojans to a 15-15 overall record and a 6-10 finish in the West Division of the Kansas Jayhawk Community College Conference.

"I look forward to the challenge," said Woods, "and believe that Colby can be very competitive in the conference next year and compete favorably at the national level."

Prior to the 2004-2005 season, Woods spent six years as the men's basketball coach for the Spartans of Western Wyoming Community College and a year as an assistant coach at Casper College (Wyo.).

Woods, a graduate of the University of Wyoming, played high

school basketball for Cheyenne East High and junior college ball at Laramie County Community College.

He spent two seasons on the basketball staff of the Wyoming Cowboys as a graduate assistant.

Marso will replace Ryan Swanson, who resigned unexpectedly on March 29 after two seasons leading the Broncbusters. Swanson's teams went 46-19 during his time at Garden City.

## Grant Mustangs finish second, fourth at Quinter

The Grant Junior High eighth-grade boys team finished second and the seventh-graders fourth at a quadrangular track and field meet Thursday in Quinter.

Leading the way for the eighth-grade Mustangs were Andrew Taylor and Zach Lohr. Taylor won the 100-meter hurdles in 17.1 seconds and Lohr cleared 5 feet, 2 inches to win the high jump.

Taylor also placed second in the long jump with a leap of 14 feet, 11.5 inches. Josh Lamb placed second in the high jump, clearing 5 feet, and was fifth in the 400-meter dash.

Colton Nelson led the seventh-grade boys, winning the discus with a throw of 101 feet, 7 inches. He placed second in the shot put and was fifth in the 100-meter dash.

Tim Roeder finished second in the 1,600-meter run. Kyle Stefan placed third in the 100-meter hurdles and Ben Waugh third in the high jump. Eduardo Martinez placed third in the 100-meter dash and was fourth at 200 meters.

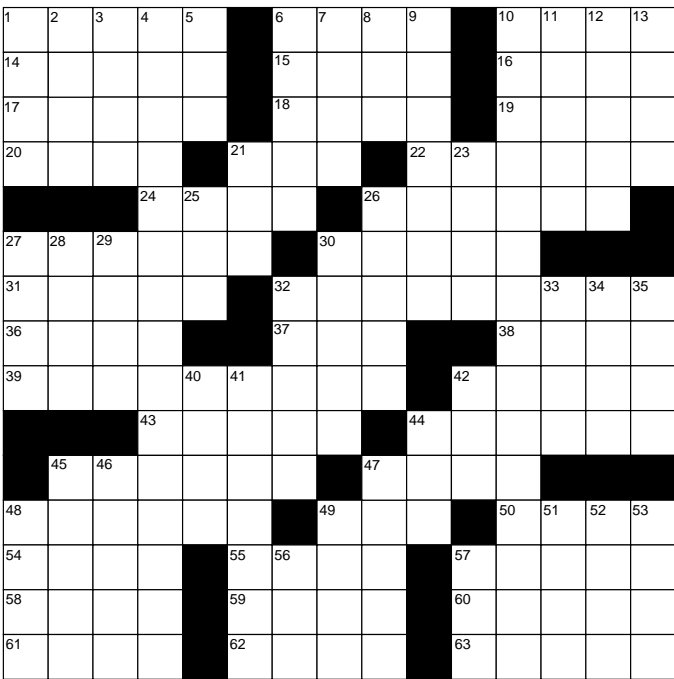
Jay Cotter finished fourth in both
