The Goodland Star-News The Colby High School softball team continued its domination over Goodland, sweeping a doubleheader from the Cowgirls on Friday at Centennial Park 15-0, after six innings, and 9-2.

On April 8 in Colby, the Lady Eagles swept a doubleheader from the Cowgirls 10-3 and 10-0 after five innings. The latest losses left Goodland 4-8 for the season.

Colby junior Sarah Redmond pitched a perfect game in Friday's opener, facing just 18 batters in six innings and striking out 11 of them. The Eagles scored their first two runs in the top of the second inning, adding four in the fourth and two more in the fifth.

Leading 8-0, Colby sent 12 batters to the plate in the top of the sixth, scoring seven runs for a 15-0 lead. In the bottom of the inning, Redmond struck out the first and third Cowgirl batters, with the second being thrown out at first. That ended the game under the "10-after-5" rule.

The Eagles' momentum kept going on into the second, as they jumped out to a 2-0 lead in the top of the first. Colby's defense held Goodland to its seventh straight "three-and-out" of the day.

The Eagles scored two more runs in the top of the second to double their lead at 4-0. Goodland go on the scoreboard in the bottom of the inning when junior Justeen Koehler scored on a passed ball. Earlier, the top of the fifth.
