

Track team finishes third

The Goodland High junior varsity finished third at a junior varsity track meet in Tribune on last Monday, with two Cowboys winning individual events.

Sophomore Troy Harrison won the 400-meter dash in 1 minute flat and cleared 5 feet, 4 inches, to win the high jump.

He placed second in the triple jump at 36 feet, 2.25 inches, and was third in the javelin.

Freshman Robert Doxon won the shot put with a heave of 39 feet, 6 inches, and placed second in the discus with a toss of 105 feet, 3 inches. Sophomore Nathan Thomas and freshman Jason Krayca both competed in the shot put and discus. Thomas also tried his hand at the javelin.

Freshman Toby Hurst placed third in both the 800 and 1,600-meter runs.

Freshman Dustin Pennington finished fourth at 800 meters and was sixth in the 1,600. Pennington also placed fourth in the long jump and fifth in the 200-meter dash.

Freshman Brett Meissinger finished fourth in the javelin and was sixth in the 200-meter dash. Freshman Matt Hamilton competed in the 100-meter dash and the long jump.

Garden City came in first with 107 points, followed by St. Francis with 76. Goodland scored 62 points. The host Greeley County High was fourth with 58 and Healy fifth with 53.
