# Cowboys set meet relay record in Oberlin

The Cowboys set a meet record on Tuesday as they finished third out of 11 teams at the Oberlin Invitational track meet.

The 4x100-meter relay team of seniors Lane Winter, Bret Jarmin and Drew Wilkens and freshman Casey Henderson won the race in 44.28 seconds, fastest ever in the meet.

Coach Don Smith said that was the highlight of the day. He said the boys' baton hand-offs were the best they had all season.

Sophomore Kerek Mason was a double winner, coming in first in both the 1,600 and 3,200-meter runs. He ran the 1,600 in 4 minutes, 58.99 seconds and the 3,200 in 10 minutes, 54.84 seconds.

Winter cleared 6 feet, 2 inches to win the high jump. He placed second in the 100-meter dash in 11.03 seconds and was third in the 200-meter dash.

Jarmin won the javelin with a throw of 165 feet, 3 inches. He also

ran in the 100-meter dash.

Wilkens placed third in the 100-meter high hurdles and was fourth in the 300-meter intermediate hurdles. Senior Wade Taylor finished sixth in the 400-meter dash and in the triple jump. Taylor also competed in the javelin.

Goodland's 4x400-meter relay team of Jarmin, Wilkens, Taylor and senior Anthony Benavides placed fifth. Benavides also competed in the 400-meter dash.

Henderson also ran in the 100 and 200-meter dashes, and did the shot put.

Other Cowboys competing in Oberlin were juniors Brandon Tatman, who ran the 200-meter dash, and did the pole vault and long jump; Cory Yarbrough who did the high and long jumps; and Jared Robinson who tried his hand at the pole vault.

Sophomore Troy Harrison ran the 400-meter dash, threw the javelin, and competed in both the high and triple jumps.

Sophomore Nathan Thomas threw the discus.

Freshmen Dustin Pennington and Toby Hurst both ran the 800 and 1,600 meters for the Cowboys. Pennington also did the long jump while Hurst did the pole vault. Freshman Robert Doxon and Jason Krayca both threw the shot and discus.

The Panthers of Phillipsburg won the boys team title, scoring 96 points. Smith Center was second

with 93. Goodland's score was 82. St. Francis finished fourth with 59 points and host Decatur Community High was fifth with 54.

Smith said this was the team's best performance of the season. He said the meet was a good preview of the competition at the Northwest Kansas League meet next Friday in Hoxie.

Both the Cowboys and Cowgirls will be in action today, starting at 2 p.m. (Mountain Time) at Colby.

# Goodland girls place seventh at Invitational

The Cowgirls track and field team finished seventh out of 11 teams at the Oberlin Invitational on Tuesday.

Leading the way for Goodland were junior Tiffany Thomas and sophomore Emily Murray, who both had second-place finishes.

Thomas ran the 1,600-meter run in 5 minutes, 54.57, and Murray ran the 300-meter hurdles in 49.72 seconds.

Senior Kara Angelos placed third in the 100-meter hurdles, with Murray finishing fifth.

Angelos also ran the 300-meter hurdles.

Fifth-place finishers for the Cowgirls were sophomores Kaylee Billinger, in the 100-meter dash, and Whitney Dautel in the 3,200-meter run.

Billinger also ran the 200-meter dash and Dautel the 1,600-meter run.

Sophomore Stephanie Sheldon cleared 7 feet in the pole vault to finish in a tie for fifth.

Sheldon also ran in the 100-meter dash.

Finishing sixth for Goodland were junior Kali Rietcheck, in the

400-meter dash; Thomas, in the 800-meter run; and junior Lisha Tedford in the shot put.

Tedford also threw the discus.

The Cowgirls' 4x100-meter relay team of Angelos, Murray, Billinger and senior Whitney Carmichael finished fourth.

Carmichael also ran the 100-meter dash.

Other Cowgirls competing in Oberlin were sophomore Emily Linden, in the 400-meter dash; sophomore Nicole David, in the javelin; freshman Halli Stone, in the 800-meter run and javelin; and freshman Amanda Amthor, in the pole vault.

Freshman Heidi Yonkey ran the 200 and 400-meter dashes, and did the long jump.

The Lady Indians of St. Francis won the girls competition with 85 points, one better than Rawlins County High.

Decatur Community, the host team, was third with 81 points and Hoxie fourth with 66.

Trego Community of WaKeeney was fifth with 59 and Smith Center sixth with 57. Goodland scored 36.5 points.
