

Race season opens

Nearly 60 vehicles participated in the first stock car races of the season Saturday at the Sherman County Speedway in Goodland.

Brian Kleine of Burlington won the Mini-Stock main race, with Dale DeLange of Burlington finishing second and Justin McClung of Goodland third.

Justin Colby of Kanorado won the Econo class main race.

Ricky Pummer of Goodland was second and Diann Ross of Goodland third.

Other Goodland drivers in the race were Marshall Carson, Brandon Troyer, Bryant Nemechek and Adam Amack.

Keith Stegman of Lamar, Colo., won the Bomber main race. Matt Geisenhagen and Jeremy Blackwell, both of Colby, finished second and third. Bomber drivers from Goodland were Drew Miller, Joey Snethen and Steve Arntt. Cameron Austin of Lamar won the Bomber "cash dash."

Ron Hill of Sharon Springs won

both the Super Stock "cash dash" and its main race. Justin Beakley of Lamar was second and Joe Shoup, also of Lamar, was third.

Twenty-six cars competed in the Jasper Modified Series main race with Ken Maloney of Kingsburg, Colo., taking first.

Darren DeLoach of Lamar was second and Brady Coen of Wiley, Colo., third.

The next event at the speedway will begin at 6:30 p.m., Saturday, June 4.

Cowley County Tigers advance, keep national title drive alive

The Cowley County Community College baseball team kept its dreams of a national title alive Sunday by defeating Cloud County Community College 6-0 in the third game of their best-two-out-of-three series.

The Tigers dominated Cloud County 11-0 in the first game Saturday at the City Ball Park in Arkansas City. However, the Thunderbirds surprised Cowley

County by coming from behind to win Saturday's second game 7-3, forcing a third game on Sunday.

The Tigers swept the Thunderbirds in a home doubleheader on March 9, 11-3 and 11-2, in their only other meeting this season.

Landon West, a 2003 graduate of Goodland High, pitches for the Tigers and is 3-2 for the season. West may see action in this weekend's

Region VI tournament.

Cowley County, now 44-12 for the season, will face Garden City Community College at 2 p.m. (Mountain Time) today at Lawrence Dumont Stadium in Wichita.

Town lays fallen soldier to rest

Lutters' sister, Genevieve Gibson, sang "I Can Only Imagine," and her daughter sang "Proud to be an American."

The Purple Heart and the Meritorious Service Metal were awarded to Lutters' parents, Chuck and Marian, before guardsmen carried the casket out of the building.

Lutters was killed while on active duty with Company A, 891st Engineering Battalion, of the Army National Guard.

Officials said a car bomb detonated near his vehicle as his unit was inspecting a bridge for enemy tampering along a supply route in southern Baghdad.

Lutters was a member of Detachment 1, 170th Maintenance Company, of Goodland, and was assigned to the 891st as a crane operator.

He was promoted to Sergeant after his death by Gen. Bunting, who had flown to Goodland Thursday to meet with the family.

Lutters was born June 26, 1980, in Goodland, the son of Marian (Dressman) and Chuck Lutters. He graduated from Goodland High

school in 1999 and attended the Northwest Kansas Technical College.

His memberships included Our Lady of Perpetual Help Catholic Church and the Knights of Columbus.

Preceding him in death were an infant sister Rebecca, his maternal grandfather, E.H. Dressman; paternal grandparents, Carl and Laura Lutters; and an uncle David Lutters.

Surviving family include his father of Goodland; his mother of Burlington; a brother, Paul and his wife Christina of Canton, Mo.; a sister, Genevieve Gibson and her husband Scot of Key Largo, Fla.; grandmother Nancy Dressman of Overland Park; five nieces and nephews, Darian, Gage and Zane Gibson, and Zoe and Grace Lutters; and aunts and uncles.

A vigil and rosary were Wednesday at the church. Graveside services were held at St. Aloysius Cemetery, Ransom.

Commissioner John Garcia agreed that the candidates need time to look at the town.

"All things about the community are important to the candidates," he said.

Mayor Rick Billinger wanted to know if the commission would be able to look at all the resumes sent to the league.

Tomb said he will send copies of all the resumes to the city after the screening, along with copies of the

top 10 for each commissioner to review.

For the top five to be interviewed, the commission agreed to pay mile-

age and an overnight stay.
