

Senior places second

Track team competes at state meet

Senior Bret Jarmin placed second in the javelin at the state Class 4A track and field meet on Friday in Cessna Stadium at Wichita State University.

Jarmin threw his javelin a career-best 185 feet, 4 inches on his first competitive throw of the meet. Austin Braman, a sophomore from Chanute High, won the event with a throw of 192 feet. Trent Mazanec of Colby finished ninth with a throw of 166 feet 7 inches.

The eight points Jarmin earned

were the only ones the Cowboys got in the meet. Goodland finished in a three-way tie for 27th place with Atchison and Augusta.

The Cowboys' 4x100-meter relay team finished seventh in its preliminary heat, running it in 44.94 seconds. Freshman Casey Henderson ran the first leg, handing the baton off to senior Drew Wilkens, who passed it on to senior Wade Taylor, with Jarmin running the anchor leg.

Colby's 4x100 team of Ryan Baalman, Travis Parker, Eli Robert and Mazanec was eighth in the same heat as Goodland finishing in 46.67 seconds. The team from Collegiate High in Wichita won the event with a time of 42.5 seconds in Saturday's final heat.

The Fighting Indians of Clearwater won the boys championship, scoring 59 points. Wamego was second with

48 and Collegiate third with 43.

Senior Kara Angelos finished sixth in her preliminary heat of the 100-meter high hurdles in 16.59 seconds. Sophomore Emily Murray was fifth in her preliminary heat of the 300-meter low hurdles in 48.89 seconds.

Junior Tiffany Thomas finished 16th in the 1,600-meter run covering the distance in 4 minutes, 55.11 seconds.

Concordia won the girls team title with 49 points, followed by Buhler with 44 and Clay Center with 40. The Lady Eagles of Colby scored 14 points, finishing in a tie for 15th with Abilene.

Colby's Lissa Mazanec placed second in the discus with a throw of 122 feet, 4 inches. Jessie Stephens placed in the top seven in two events, finishing fourth in the 3,200-meter run and sixth at 1,600 meters.

Ex-Cowboy heads south to play football for Arizona

Goodland's J.C. Zahradnik will continue his college football career next season with the Wildcats of the University of Arizona.

Zahradnik played the past two seasons for Butler County Community College in El Dorado, earning honorable mention as a defensive end in 2004 from the Kansas Jayhawk Community College Conference. He recorded 49 tackles his sophomore year, including six quarterback sacks, and recovered two fumbles. As a freshman, he had 13 tackles including a sack.

In addition to being the Grizzlies' starting right defensive end in 2004, Zahradnik was the team's long snapper on punts and field goals, and a team captain.

With Zahradnik on the roster, Butler County went 23-1, winning the National Junior College Athletic



Association championship in 2003. The Grizzlies were the national runners-up last year, losing to Pearl River Community College (Miss.) 35-14 in the Dalton Defenders Bowl on Nov. 28.

J.C. is the son of Gary and Joy Seemann of Cordell, Okla.

He is the grandson of Dale and Iva Lee Stephens of Goodland and Ernst and Rosalie Seemann of Levant. He lived with his family in Goodland until 1997, moving to Colby and later to Anthony, where he graduated from Chaparral High School in 2003.

The Wildcats, who finished 3-8 last season, are led by second-year coach Mike Stoops. Arizona, a member of the Pacific 10 Conference, opens its season with a non-conference game on Sept. 2 against Utah in Salt Lake City.
