Mary Lou Franklin

Mary Lou Franklin, 82, a retired Goodland farm wife, died Sunday, June 5, 2005, at her home.

She was born Nov. 30, 1922, at Collinsville, Ill., the daughter of Catherine (Genetti) and Isaac Wilshire, and graduated from Collinsville High School.

On May 22, 1944, she married Wilbert Franklin at Collinsville. In 1946, after his discharge from the Navy, the Franklins moved to Kansas to farm with his uncle in northeast Rawlins County. Robert Eugene Waugh Jr., 51, Story, Wyo., formerly a railroad engineer in Goodland, died Tuesday, June 7, 2005, at the Memorial Hospital of Sheridan County, Wyo.

He was born Dec. 20, 1953, in Emporia, the son of Robert Eugene and Margaret Ellen (Gaughan) Waugh Sr. He grew up in Reading, Olivet and Goodland and graduated from Goodland High School in 1971.

Waugh went to work as a fireman for the Rock Island Railroad in Goodland in July 1971. He received his engineer training in Goodland.

He moved to the Denver area, where he continued working for

Rock Island. He signed on with the Burlington Northern Railroad in 1977 as a locomotive engineer at Edgemont, S.D., and transferred to the Sheridan Division in 1990, living in Story.

Waugh was a member of the Brotherhood of Locomotive Engineers, where he held various offices. He was a Catholic and attended Our Lady of the Pines Catholic Church in Story.

He was an avid hunter, fisherman, golfer and camper. He loved the outdoors, especially the mountains, and considered himself a "mountain man."

Survivors include his parents of Goodland; three brothers, Tom Waugh of Ocean Shores, Wash., Mike Waugh of Spearfish, S.D., and Scott Waugh of Goodland; and three sisters, Catherine Waugh of Man-

hattan, Kan., Marcia Honer of Coppell, Texas, and Lynn Waugh of Manhattan.

A memorial Mass will be held at 10 a.m. today, Friday, June 10, 2005, at Holy Name Catholic Church in Sheridan, Wyo., with Father Thomas Ogg officiating.
