# Goodland swimmers take fifth at Wray, bring home six golds

The Goodland swim team finished fifth last Saturday at a meet in Wray, Colo., claiming gold medals in six individual events and one relay race.

Daniel Blake won all three of his events in boys 15-18 competition. He took the 100-yard freestyle in 59.61 seconds, the 100-yard butterfly in 1 minute, 11.27 seconds and the 100-yard breaststroke in 1:24.34.

In the 8-and-under boys competition, Gerell Miller won the 50-yard freestyle in 51.33 and the 25-yard breaststroke in 25.37. He placed second in the 25-yard breaststroke swimming it in 26.39.

Miller teamed with Alex Goodwin, Kelsey White and Drew House to win the 8-and-under mixed 100-yard freestyle relay in 2:24.29. Miller and House teamed up with Carlee Cooper and Rachel Horney to place second in the 100-yard medley relay in 2:11.27.

Brennan Clouse won the boys 13-14 100-yard freestyle in 1:03.72. Clouse placed second in the 50-yard freestyle, 27.75, and in the 100-yard breaststroke, 1:24.34.

Clouse teamed with Hannah Blake, Cassie Cooper and Chelsey Horney to finish second in both the

13-14 mixed 200-yard freestyle and medley relays.

Riley O'Harah won the 11-12 boys 50-yard freestyle in 32.93 and was second at 100 yards finishing in 1:14.09. He placed third in the 50-yard breaststroke.

Hannah Blake placed second in the 13-14 girls 100-yard freestyle swimming it in 1:09.91. She also placed fourth in both the 50-yard freestyle and the 100-yard butterfly.

Holton Witman finished third in the 9-10 boys 25-yard backstroke, fourth in the 25-yard freestyle and sixth in the 100-yard freestyle.

Witman teamed up with Ellie House, Zach Miller and Brianna White to place second in the 9-10 mixed 100-yard medley relay. Holden Hoover and Drew Dautel joined up with Witman and Miller to finish fourth in the 9-10 boys 100-yard freestyle relay.

Drew House placed fourth in the 8-and-under boys 25-yard breaststroke and fifth in the 25-yard freestyle. Halli Stone finished fourth in the 15-18 girls 100-yard backstroke.

Chelsey Horney was fifth in both the 13-14 girls 100-yard freestyle and 100-yard butterfly. Her sister Rachel was fifth the 8-and-under

50-yard freestyle and sixth in the 25-yard butterfly.

Other sixth-place finishers for Goodland were Alex Goodwin in the 8-and-under boys 25-yard backstroke, Taryn Bedore in the 9-10 girls 100-yard individual medley, Zach Miller in the 9-10 boys 100-yard individual medley, Drew Dautel in the 9-10 boys 25-yard backstroke and Parker Sieck in the 11-12 boys 100-yard freestyle.

Goodland's 9-10 girls finished sixth in two relays.

Chloe Goodwin, Ellie House, Taryn Bedore and Shycol Woodrow swam the 100-yard freestyle relay; and Woodrow, Goodwin and Bedore teamed up with Berkley White for the 100-yard medley relay.

Other Goodland swimmers in Wray were Alicia and Ashley Barrie, Caleb Wallsmith and Madison Hoover.

Colby won the meet with 374 points, followed by Holyoke with 178 and Burlington with 166. Oberlin finished fourth with 188. Goodland scored 109. Following, in order, were Wray, St. Francis, Oakley, Flagler and Limon.

The next meet is Saturday in Burlington.

# Ex-Cowboy takes team to basketball nationals

Goodland native Mitch Thompson is in Omaha this weekend to help lead the Baylor University baseball team in the NCAA Division I national championship, the 59th College World Series.

Thompson is in his 11th season as an assistant coach for Steve Smith, who became the Bears' coach in July 1994. Thompson is the team's hitting coach and also works with the outfielders. He has eight Baylor players batting .250 or better.

Thompson began his coaching career in 1990 as a graduate assistant for the Bulldogs of Mississippi State University. He spent the 1991 season as an assistant coach at Radford University before return-

ing to Mississippi State for the 1992 and 1993 seasons.

Thompson joined the staff at Baylor after spending the 1994 season as an assistant at Auburn, where he helped lead the Tigers to the College World Series.

Mitch, the son of Mac and Pat Thompson of Goodland, is a 1983 graduate of Goodland High. He played college ball at Fort Hays State, graduating in 1988. Mitch earned a master's degree in physical education from Mississippi State in 1991. He and his wife Amber have two daughters Mary, 8, and Caroline, 5.

Baylor earned a spot in the College series by defeating Clemson 6-1 at the super-regional tournament in Waco, Texas, on Monday. The

Bears enter the series 44-22 overall. They finished in a tie for first place in the Big 12 Conference with the University of Nebraska. Both had 19-8 records.

Nebraska, 56-13 overall, and Texas, 51-16, also advanced to the series from the Big 12. The other five teams are Florida, Tennessee, Arizona State, Tulane and Oregon State.

Baylor faces Texas in the first round at 5 p.m. Mountain Time Saturday at Omaha's Johnny Rosenblatt Stadium. The game will be broadcast by ESPN (S&T cable channel 56, Eagle channel 22).

The Bears swept all four games they played against Texas this season, the last time by one run, 9-8, on May 28 in the semifinals of the conference tournament. Baylor lost 1-0 to Nebraska the next day for the Big 12 title.

# Junior golfers win gold in tourney at Colby

a 62 and Gannon a 68. Thatcher Jones shot an 89 in that bracket.
