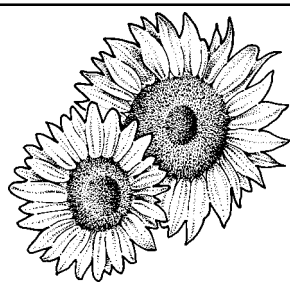

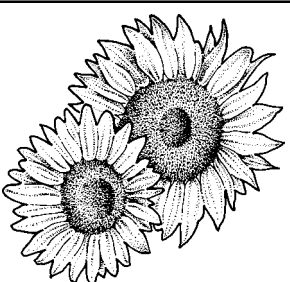

Music, sports, citizenship awards given

Citizenship Awards went to Michelle Smith and Devin Mangus. The Citizenship Award is a Kansas State High School Ac-

tivities Association program; it can be awarded each year to one boy and one girl.

"There is a list of qualifications the students are judged on," said Principal Jim Mull. "After all the nominations are in, I have the staff vote on three names, and the top ones get the award."

Citizenship is judged on reverence for the flag, tolerance of others, academics and respect for others.

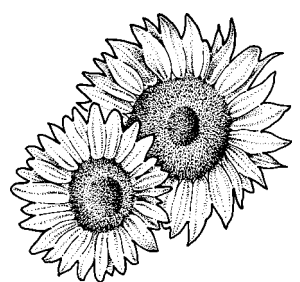
The Goodland Elks presented each Citizenship Award winner with a \$50 savings bond, and their names appear on a plaque in the trophy case at the school.

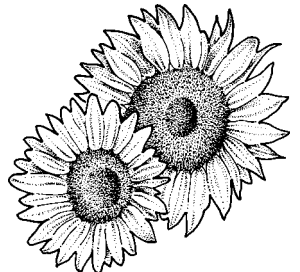


