Goodland takes top three, twice

Four Goodland golfers won gold medals at a Northwest Kansas Junior Golf Association tournament Monday at the Sugar Hills Golf Club.

Goodland players swept the top three spots in the 8-9 year-old boys competition, with Gannon Ihrig first with an 11-over-par 47 for the front nine holes.

Tanner Jones placed second with a 51 and Gage Ihrig, Gannon's twin, was third with a 54.

Joe Diaz also competed in this category, shooting an 87.

Another top-three sweep for Goodland was in the 12-13 girls bracket, with Chelsie Gausman winning the gold with a 59 for nine holes.

Natashia Hillman was second with 61 and Amber Douglas finished third with 66.

Goodland's Kaitlyn Topliff shot a 70 and her twin sister Kirsten had a 71.

Eryn Topliff won the 14-15 girls gold medal, shooting a 120 for 18 holes.

Heidi Yonkey placed second with a 134.

Nathan Linin shot a one-over-par 72 to win the 16-17 boys bracket.

Mikey Doll finished third with a 91. Ryan Gausman shot a 97.

Goodland's Shaina Sapp placed second in 8-9 girls with a score of 104.

In the 10-11 boys competition, Tyler Jones finished second with a 46 on the front nine.

Joel Linin placed third with a 55.

Other Goodland players in this category were Derek Matthews, 72, and Jordan McCombs, 85.

Competing in the 12-13 boys bracket were Devin Garrett, who shot a 64 on the back nine; David Murry, 76; Brock Wilkens, 74; Nathan Deeds, 81; and J.P. McCool, 87.

Brandon Douglas competed in the 14-15 boys category, shooting a 109 for 18 holes.

On June 20, five Goodland players competed in a tournament at the Oberlin Country Club.

Amber Douglas won the 12-13 girls competition and Amber Webster won the 14-15 girls.

Tanner Jones finished second in the 8-9 boys competition.

His brother Tyler was second in 10-11 boys play.

Their brother Thatcher played in the 8-9 bracket in Oberlin.

The next tournament for the association's West Division will be Monday in Hoxie.

Track and field athletes ready for regional meet

Two Goodland track and field athletes will be in Joplin, Mo., this weekend for the AAU Region VIII championship meet being held at Missouri Southern State University.

Michele Smith will compete in the youth girls' discus, and Kerek Mason will compete in the young men's 3,000-meter run. Both qualified for the region meet by placing among the top four in their respective events.

Smith placed second in the discus with a throw of 94 feet 7 inches at the Missouri Valley championships held last weekend at Center High School in Kansas City, Mo., She also placed fifth in the shot put with a heave of 31 feet 3.5 inches.

Smith qualified for the Missouri

Valley meet in both the discus and shot put based on her efforts at the Hays Strider qualifying meet on

June 4. Her distances were added to the performance lists in her category and were good enough to allow her to compete in Kansas City.

Mason qualified for the region meet in the 3,000 by finishing third at the Missouri Valley championships. His time was 10 minutes 37.39 seconds.

Mason also competed in the 400-meter dash and 1,500-meter run placing 11th and seventh, respectively.

Goodland's Dustin Pennington

competed in the intermediate boys 1,500-meter run at the meet finishing 11th.

Both Mason and Pennington qualified for last week's meet at the Kansas state championships held June 10-11 at CiCo Park in Manhattan. Mason's third-place finish in the 3,000 there gave him an automatic spot in the Missouri Valley meet. He qualified in his other two events based on his standings on the performance lists. Pennington also advanced through the performance list.

The top four athletes in each event this weekend advance to the Junior Olympic Games to be held from July 30 to August at Tad Gormley Stadium in New Orleans.
