

American Legion loses two at Ulysses

Goodland's American Legion baseball team ended its season last weekend at the double-elimination zone tournament in Ulysses.

Goodland went 1-2 at the tournament losing to Colby 5-2 and beating Gove County 13-5 on Friday, then losing to Scott City 13-12 on Saturday. The team finished the season 14-17 overall.

In Goodland's first game of the tourney, Colby scored four runs in the top of the first inning to take the early lead. After holding Goodland scoreless in the bottom of the first, Colby added another run in the top of the second to take a 5-0 lead.

In the bottom of the second, Goodland got on the scoreboard when Andrew Pettibone hit a

double to left field driving in Derek Fenner who got on base with a walk then stole second to get into scoring position. However, that was all Goodland could score in the inning.

Neither team scored in the third and fourth innings. In the top of the fifth, Goodland's defense held Colby to a "three and out." Pettibone walked to start the bottom of the fifth then advanced to second on a single by Randy Young. Wyatt Dautel batted next hitting a double to left center field scoring Pettibone and making the score 5-2.

Neither team scored in the sixth or seventh innings sending Goodland to the bottom bracket to immediately face Gove County.

In the top of the first inning, Gove

County jumped out to a 2-0 lead then held Goodland to a "three and out" in the bottom of the inning. Goodland returned the favor in the top of the second, then scored four runs in the bottom of the second highlighted by a double to left field by Brandon Zelfer that drove in a run.

After holding Gove County scoreless in the top of the third, Goodland added a pair of runs in the bottom of the inning to increase its lead to 6-2.

Both teams scored three runs in the fourth inning to make the score 9-5.

Again, Goodland held its opponent scoreless in the top of the fifth. The Goodland team exploded for four runs on five hits, including

doubles by Young and Jake Johnson, making it 13-5 and ending the game by rule.

The next day Goodland faced Scott City, the tournament's top seed. In the top of the first, Scott City's first batter hit a double to left center, which was immediately followed by a two-run homer by Stephen Busch. After that Goodland's defense stiffened not allowing any more runs even though Scott City managed to load the bases with only one out.

In the bottom of the first, Goodland came back to tie the score. Dautel started things off with a single then two batters later scored on a hit by Jake Alander who himself was driven in on a hit by Fenner.

Scott City retook the lead in the top of the second when Grant Geyer hit a triple driving in a run to make it 3-2. Goodland again came back to tie the score in the bottom of the inning when Tad Taylor hit a double to left center field scoring Zelfer who got on earlier with a single.

Scott City scored a run in the top of the third then scored two more in the top of the fourth, after holding Goodland scoreless in the bottom of the third, to take a 6-3 lead into the bottom of the fourth.

Goodland came back to take its only lead of the game, 7-6, in the bottom of the fourth during which the team sent 10 batters to the plate scoring four runs.

However, Scott City outscored

Goodland 2-0 in the fifth to retake the lead 8-7.

In the top of the sixth, Scott City exploded for five runs highlighted by a two-run triple by David Hyde making the score 13-7 going into the bottom of the inning.

There Zelfer hit a three-run homer which highlighted a four-run inning by Goodland to get within two at 13-11.

Goodland's defense kept Scott City scoreless in the top of the seventh, but on offense the team could only manage one run making the final 13-12 ending its season.

Scott City went on to win the zone tournament and will advance to the state tournament in Pratt on Aug. 3-7.
