Rodeo bulls thrill crowd

Over 40 cowboys gave the crowd a thrill as they pitted their skill against the brut strength of the bulls at the Northwest Kansas District Free Fair on Tuesday.

The grandstands and the bleachers on the north and south were full as a crowd estimated at 1,500 to 2,000 watched contestants take their eight seconds of fame — if they could hang on that long.

Jesse Kirby of Dodge City came away as the big winner in the Thunder on the Plains bull riding, with 155 points on two rides. He won \$1,305 for the top average and \$1,080 as the top rider in the short round.

All of the cowboys rode in the long round and the top 10 came back for the short round.

Two of the top 10 managed to reach the eight-second whistle. Kirby had the top score, followed by Bowdy Peach of Moran, Okla.,

with a score of 73. He won \$720 in the short round.

Peach was second in average, picking up \$1,080 for his 148 points on two rides.

In the long round, Aaron Walker of Fort Worth rode the bull Sooner for a high score of 85 points and a prize of \$1,080. Walker picked up \$855 as third place in the over all average.

Skeeter Kingsolver, 15, of Lawrence rode Black Bart for a 79 and second place in the long round. He picked up \$810 for that, plus \$630 for finishing fourth in total average.

Strike Three got Jerod Wright of Golden Valley, Ariz., third place in the long round with a score of 76 and a check for \$540. The ride was good enough for fifth overall and Kingsolver got \$405 for that.

Kyle Cudmore of Cherokee, Okla., was fourth in the long round with a 75. He got \$270 for that, and

\$225 for sixth place overall.

Area riders included K. Lee Jones of Sharon Springs, Cauby Hudson of Tribune, Todd Huston of Scott City and Nate Williams of Norton.

Sponsors of the bulls had a chance for a prize, and the top went to Pizza Hut for sponsoring Sooner, which was the top ride for Walker.

Rodeo clowns Cory Wall of Burlington, Tracy Weeter of Goodland and Cody Woelk of Tribune worked the arena.

Kirby got a chance at a prize sponsored by Eklund Insurance Agency on the "bounty bull," Amarillo.

He lasted about three seconds on the top-ranked bull.

The bulls came from Hudson Rodeo Co., Rice Bucking Bulls, Dean Drake and Shraeder and Son. Several have been ranked high in the Professional Bull Riding circuit, and have appeared on television, organizers said.
