# Bethel volleyball team tops poll

The Lady Threshers of Bethel College topped the Kansas Collegiate Athletic Conference's coaches preseason volleyball poll with five of the nine first-place votes.

Tabor College received three first-place votes, finishing second in the poll. Ottawa University was third, getting the other top vote. Tabor and Ottawa both went 15-3 in conference play last season, finishing in a tie for the regular season championship.

Ottawa defeated Bethel 3-0 in the championship match of last year's post-season tournament and earned a spot in the national playoffs. Ot-

tawa lost to Dordt College (Iowa) in the first round of the regionals.

Sterling College was fourth in the poll, followed by, in order, Kansas Wesleyan University, McPherson College, Friends University, the University of St. Mary, Southwestern College and Bethany College.

Sarah Hill of Sharon Springs is starting her freshman season at Kansas Wesleyan. The Lady Coyotes open their season with a home match next Tuesday against Oklahoma Wesleyan University.

Sarah, the daughter of Gary and Delphine Hill, is a 2005 graduate of Wallace County High School. She played four seasons on the Lady Wildcats' volleyball team.
