

Cowgirls play tough, but end up 1-2 at league meet

The Cowgirls volleyball team went 1-2 in pool play at the Northwest Kansas League tournament Saturday in Quinter.

"We played everyone tough but was unable to pull out the wins," said Coach Jerry McKee. "Almost every match at league went to three games. The league was very balanced this year."

All three of Goodland's matches went to three games, with the Cowgirls falling first to Hoxie 26-28, 25-9 and 25-20, then to Oberlin 25-22, 16-25 and 25-15. The Cowgirls regrouped against Quinter, beating the Lady Bulldogs 17-25, 25-14 and 30-28.

Oberlin finished 3-0 in pool play with Hoxie going 2-1 and Quinter 0-3.

In the other pool, it was the Lady Eagles of Colby who went 3-0 with Oakley, Atwood and St. Francis all finishing 1-2.

Colby defeated Hoxie in one semi-final match 21-25, 25-17 and 25-22, and Oberlin beat Oakley 25-16, 25-22 in the other.

In the championship match, it was the Red Devils of Oberlin defeating Colby 27-25, 21-25 and 25-23.

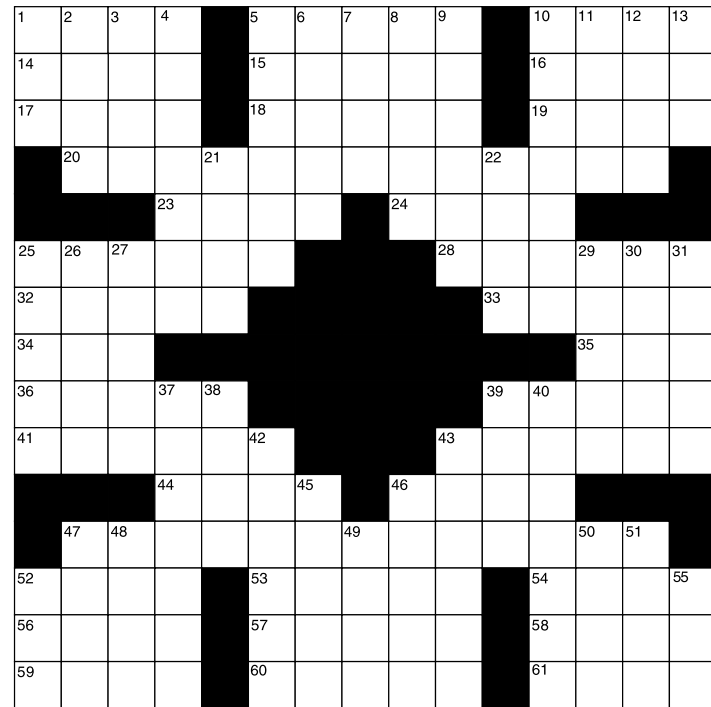
The Cowgirls, 15-17 for the season, now have the rest of this week to get ready for the Class 4A sub-state tournament Saturday in Ulysses.
