

Ex-Cowgirl leads team with 14 kills

Alisha McKee, a sophomore middle blocker for California State University, Fresno, led her team with 14 kills Monday in the Lady Bulldogs' 3-0 loss at Utah State University.

The game scores were 30-24, 30-27 and 30-21. Fresno State is now 4-15 overall and 2-7 in the Western Athletic Conference. The Bulldogs won their first meeting with the Aggies 3-2 on Oct. 5 in Fresno.

McKee, a 2004 graduate of Goodland High, got her 12th start of the season against Utah State. She has played in 16 of Fresno State's 19 matches this season

McKee, in her second season with the Bulldogs, is second on the team in blocks with 36. With her 14 kills Monday, McKee is now third on the kill list with 126.

The Bulldogs began a four-game home Thursday against San Jose State University and will face the University of Hawaii on Saturday. The Rainbow Wahine of Hawaii are

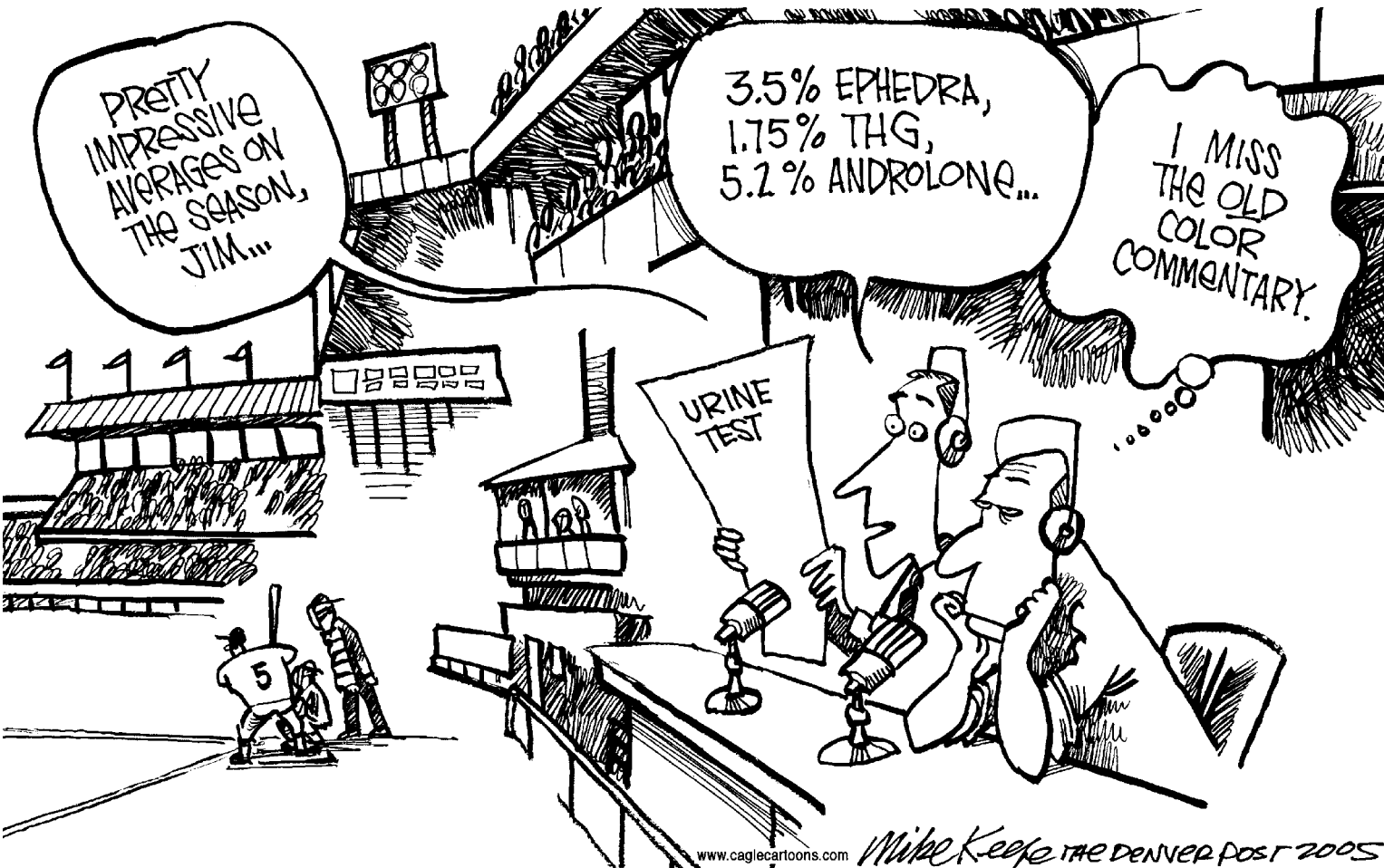
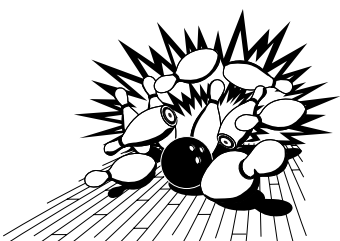


Sophomore Alisha McKee of Fresno State went up for a block during Monday's road match against Utah State University.

Tabor Bluejays remain unbeaten

The Bluejays of Tabor College in Hillsboro are one of just four undefeated football teams left this season in the National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics.

The team improved to 7-0 last Saturday after defeating Southwestern College 45-28. Tabor moved up two spots to No. 8 in the association's national poll released Monday. The Bluejays visit Ottawa University on Saturday.

The Coyotes of Kansas Wesleyan University improved to 6-1 overall for the season with a 20-17 win over the Bulldogs of McPherson College. The Coyotes also rose two spots in this week's poll to No. 19. Kansas Wesleyan plays at home Saturday after a three-game road stretch taking on Bethel College.

Colby native Brent Deibert, a

junior defensive end for the Coyotes, has seen action in six of the team's seven games, recording 13 tackles including a quarterback sack. Deibert started his college career at Garden City Community College.

In other games last Saturday around the Kansas Collegiate Athletic Conference, the Falcons of Friends University beat the Braves of Ottawa 34-0; the University of St. Mary defeated Bethel 10-3; and the Warriors of Sterling College beat Betheny College 34-21.

On Saturday, McPherson travels to Bethany; St. Mary heads to Sterling; and Friends goes to Winfield to face Southwestern.

The Pioneers of MidAmerica Nazarene University in Olathe, members of the Heart of America

Athletic Conference, moved up one spot in the poll to No. 5 this week. The Pioneers are 6-1 for the season.
