

# Brewster man fights leukemia

A Brewster man's physical for life insurance may have saved his life, but he will have to fight for it.

The Brewster Community Church is raising money to help his family with that fight.

Mark Flanders, owner of Flanders Guttering, was trying to get life insurance and ended up finding out he has acute lymphoblastic leukemia.

Flanders, 33, thought the pain he was in was because of his weight, said Diane Flanders, his sister-in-law. But when he went to get life insurance, she said, they told him to go to a doctor; his blood wasn't right.

That was just in the last few weeks, she said; he has started chemotherapy, and they are planning a bone marrow transplant in January. Flanders and his wife Jamie have five children.

The church is having a benefit bake sale for the family from 8 a.m. to noon Central Time Saturday at the Frontier Equity Exchange in Brewster.
