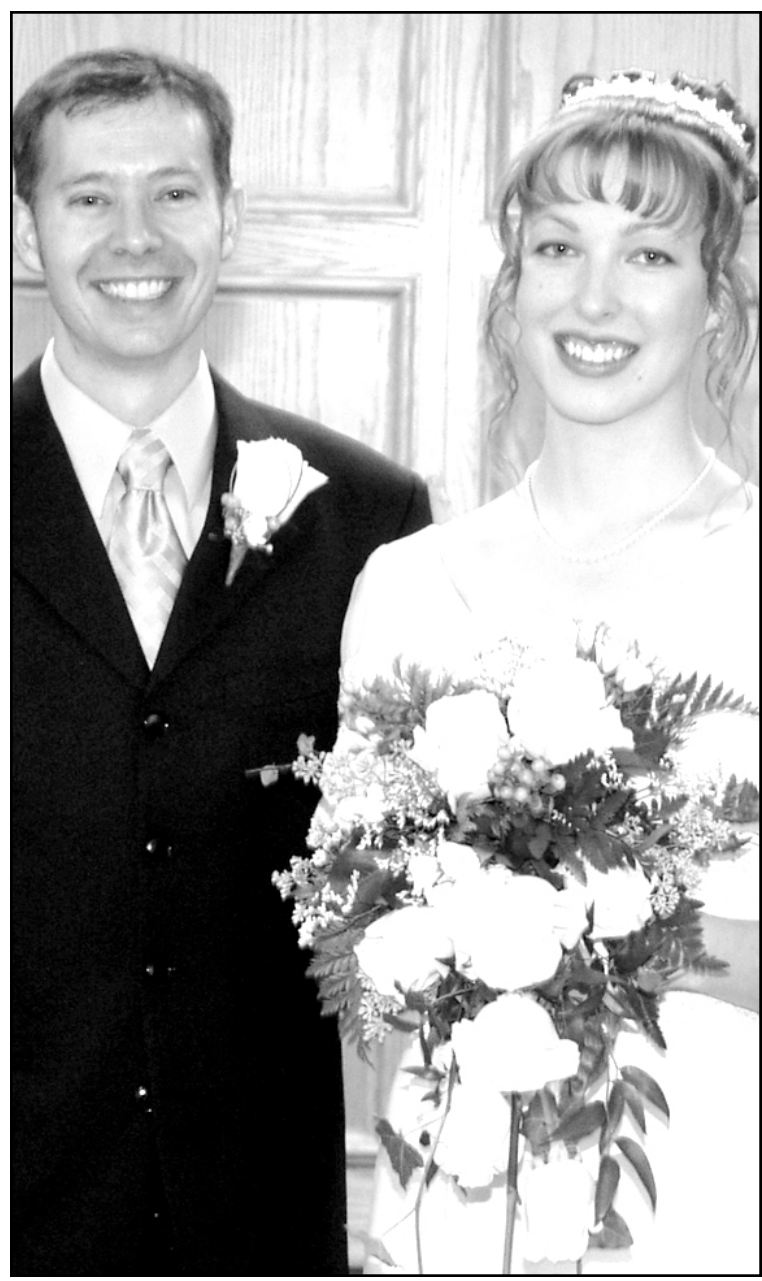

Retired dentist dies four days after car crash

A retired Goodland dentist died last Friday as a result of injuries he received in a traffic accident four days before.

Dr. John L. Beynon, 81, Aurora, Colo., who cleaned, repaired and cared for teeth in Goodland from 1966-2001, died Friday, Dec. 2, 2005, resulting from injuries in an accident that happened Monday, Nov. 28, in Lakewood, Colo.

He loved his dentistry and loved working with people, his wife, Mar-

garet Beynon, said. He was happy, cheerful, she said, and he was a very private person.

Dr. Beynon was born Sept. 21, 1924, in Denver, the son of Lewis and Agnes (O’Day) Beynon. He went to schools in Frederick, Colo., graduating in 1942.

Beynon enlisted in the Navy in 1943 and served in the Pacific until 1946. He returned to college at the University of Northern Colorado and graduated in 1949. He coached basketball

in Johnstown, Colo., for two years.

In August 1955, he married Margaret Kurtz. They celebrated their 55th anniversary this year.

Beynon went to dental school at the University of Missouri at Kansas City and graduated in 1964. He practiced in Goodland from 1966 until he retired in 2001. The Beynons moved to Heather Gardens, a retirement community, in Aurora, Colo., in 2002.

He was a member of the Catholic Church, the American Dental Association, the Northwest Kansas Dental Association, Psi Omega

dental fraternity and the Delta Psi fraternity at the University of Northern Colorado, Greeley.



Survivors include his wife and a sister, Mary Kay Brown of Casper, Wyo.
