Indians beat Cowboys

The Indians of Hays High scored first in their game against the Cowboys this Tuesday at Max Jones Fieldhouse and led throughout to win 76-69.

Hays junior Kameron Parker scored the game's first two points less than five seconds after the tipoff, forcing the Cowboys to play catch up from the start. A little over a minute later, Parker hit a three-pointer to make it a 5-0 lead for the Indians.

Junior Mikey Doll got Goodland on the scoreboard with a free throw, followed a short time later by a basket by junior Nick Angelos to make it 5-3. After Hays scored on a basket, a three-pointer by senior Wyatt Dautel got the Cowboys to within one at 7-6. That was they closest they came all night.

An 8-point run by Hays made the score 15-6, and after that, the Indians were able to respond to nearly every move the Cowboys made until the final buzzer.

Both teams scored seven points after the run by Hays to make the score 22-13 going into the second period.

About halfway through the quarter, senior Jace Herl intercepted a pass and drove in for a layup which started an 8-point run for Goodland. That got the Cowboys within five at

34-29. However, the Indians scored nine straight to close the period and take a 43-29 lead into the locker room at halftime.

Hays scored the first four points of the third period while keeping Goodland scoreless for the first two minutes, increasing the Indians' lead to 18 at 47-29. After that, the Cowboys outscored Hays 14-9 but trailed 56-43 going into the fourth quarter.

More than four minutes into the fourth quarter, the Indians still led by 13 at 67-54. A basket by senior Derek Fenner followed by one by Herl and another by junior Landon Williams got Goodland within seven at 67-60 but Hays responded with a 6-point run of its own and the margin remained 13 with less than a minute left.

Doll hit a three-pointer with 25 seconds left to make it 73-63. After a free throw by Hays, Dautel hit his third three-pointer of the game, making the score 74-66 with 10 seconds left.

Goodland fouled to stop the clock with nine seconds showing, but the Indians' Drew Steffan hit both free throws to make it 76-66. Six seconds later, Dautel hit another three-pointer to make the final 76-69.

The win lifted Hays to 5-1 for the season while the Cowboys fell to 4-2.

Three Cowboys scored in double

figures, led by Herl with 19. Fenner scored 16 points and Dautel 14. Twelve of Dautel's points came from three-point range.

Williams tossed in nine points for Goodland, with Angelos scoring five, Doll four and senior Jon Beeson two.

Herl also led the team in rebounds with eight and in assists with seven.

Hays held a slight edge in shooting from the floor, hitting 50.9 percent of its field goals compared to an even 50 percent for Goodland. However, the Indians scored on 86 percent of their free throws compared to 61 percent for the Cowboys, and outrebounded the home team 33-19.

Hays sophomore Jason Ball scored a career-high 25 points. Other Indians in double-figures were Matt Stramel with 16, Michael Selby with 11 and Parker with 10.

The Cowboys will try to get back on the winning trail tonight in Quinter as they open play in the Northwest Kansas League against the Bulldogs.

The game, which tips off around 7:30 p.m. (Mountain Time), will be broadcast live by Goodland radio KLOE (730 AM) with Andrew Melia calling the play-by-play.

The Bulldogs defeated Wheatland High of Grainfield on Tuesday, 71-56 improving to 5-0 for the season.


