#### ORDINANCE NO. 1541

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 3, ARTICLE 4, "AN-NEXED LAND" AND PARA-GRAPHS 2 AND 5 OF SEC-TION "I-2" HEAVY INDUS-TRIAL DISTRICT SET FORTH INARTICLE4 OF THE CITY OF **REGULATIONS** as follows:

NO. 1467 OF THE CITY OF GOODLAND, KANSAS.

**BEITORDAINED BY THE CITY** COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF GOODLAND, KANSAS:

#### **SECTION 1:**

That Section 3, of Article 4 of the City of Goodland, Kansas Zoning Regulations, entitled Annexed Land is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

3. Annexed Land: All land which may hereinafter be annexed to the City of Goodland shall be classified "R-1", Residential - Single-family District unless the intended use of the property requires being zoned otherwise, which may be requested at the time of Annexation. Land shall be re-classified after Annexation only after a Public Hearing by the Planning Commission and recommendation to the Governing Body as provided in these regulations for zoning district amendments.

#### SECTION 2:

That Paragraphs 2 and 5 of "I-2" Heavy Industrial District of Article 4 of the City of Goodland, Kansas Zoning Regulations is hereby amended so as to read

2. <u>Permitted Uses</u>: Generally, Heavy Manufacturing, Salvage Yards, Quarrying, Wholesaling, Trucking and Warehousing uses are permitted. For a general listing of permitted and conditional uses see Article 5 of the City of Goodland, Kansas Zoning Regulations. The permitted uses will be determined based on compatibility with other uses permitted in the district and with uses listed in Article 5.

5. Height Regulations: Maximum Height of Structures: 45 feet if within 150 feet of a Residential District: Otherwise the limitations as specified in the Goodland Municipal Airport Airspace Plan (Part 77) shall apply.

#### **SECTION 3:**

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.
