A citizen of the United States who is eighteen (18) years of age or older, or will have attained the age of eighteen (18) at the next state general election, must register before he or she can vote. Registration closes fourteen (14) days prior to every election.

When a registered voter changes residence or name, such voter must reregister in order to be eligible to vote. Any person may apply in person or by telephone, or by mail to the County Election Officer to be registered. Application forms shall be provided by the County election Officer upon request by the applicant. Such application shall be signed by the applicant under penalty of perjury.
