4-Hers to compete at Regionals next Friday in Brewster

About 20 Goodland 4-H members are eligible to compete at Regional 4-H Days next Friday in Brewster.

Fifteen youngsters and two 4-H clubs earned Regional Blue ribbons at the 4-H Days and Talent Night on Friday, March 10, at Goodland High School, and eight alternates were chosen.

Regional Blues for project talks and demonstrations went to Dani Mangus and Chandler Pettibone in junior project talks, Sydney Winston and Christie Studer in intermediate project talks, Elizabeth House and Saige Vandiver in junior demonstration, Winston and Lacie Cowan in intermediate demonstration, and Jason Krayca and Devin Mangus in senior demonstration and illustrated talk.

Alternates were Sarah Johnson in junior project talks, Cooper Slough in intermediate project talks and Katelyn Coon in intermediate demonstration.

Garrett Nemechek, Cody Hooker and Mikail Freeman received blue ribbons in intermediate project talks, and Jessica Johnson received a blue in junior demonstration.

Adam Duell received blues in senior demonstration and illustrated talks, and T.J. Freeman earned a red. Clouse participated in senior public speaking.

In intermediate instrumental, Paige Phillips and Kendra Promise earned red ribbons. In junior vocal duet, Shyanne Austin and Miranda Hernandez earned blues.

In Model Meetings, Regional Blue went to Prairie Dale, alternate to Sunflower and blues to Beaver Valley, Country Clovers, Glendale Livewires and Ruleton Eager Beavers.


