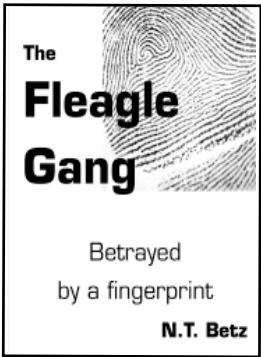

Nefarious Kansas criminals Fingerprint ends nationwide '20s manhunt



‘Betrayed by a Fingerprint’ — A definite Must Read

“The Fleagle Gang” details the robbery/murder case which hinged on a single fingerprint — *precursor to today’s CSI shows* — found on a murdered Dighton, Kan., doctor’s car. The fledgling FBI plays a crucial role in turning the fingerprint into solid forensic evidence used to find, arrest and convict members of the Fleagle Gang. The FBI credits the Fleagle case as the first time a single fingerprint was used to identify and convict criminals.

The Fleagle Gang robbed banks in Larned, Kinsley, Marysville, Ottawa and McPherson Kan., Laramie, Colo., Eugene, Ore. and committed others worth \$1 million in the 10 years they operated. 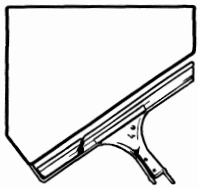
