## When do crops need water the most?

The goal of farmers in northwest Kansas is to use available water as efficiently as possible to generate crop yields.

Every crop has a certain growth period during which water stress can have a big effect on yields.

In general, grain crops are more sensitive to water deficiencies during flowering and early seed formation than during vegetative and ripening phases. Limited irrigation should be timed to avoid water stress at these critical stages, said Loyd Stone, a Kansas State University soil physics professor. This will give the greatest yield benefit from a limited water resource.




