Three place among top eight at track classic

Three Goodland High School athletes placed among the top eight in their events Friday at the 58th annual K.T. Woodman Track Classic in Wichita's Cessna Stadium. Junior Kaylee Billinger placed fifth in the Class 3A-4A girls 400-meter dash in 1 minute, 3.44 seconds. Billinger finished 12th in both in the 100- and 200-meter dashes, with times of 13.55 and 28.09 seconds. Junior Stephanie Sheldon cleared

9 feet to place sixth in the girls pole vault. Sheldon and junior Whitney Dautel ran the 800 meters, Dautel in 2:43.29 and Sheldon in 2:47.09. Dautel also ran the 3,200 meters, in 13:33.12. Junior Kerek Mason was seventh in the boys 3,200-meter, finishing in 4:45.77. He ran the 100-meter dash in 12.41 seconds and the 800-meters in 2:08.22. Other Goodland entries at the Classic were seniors Kali Rietcheck

and Lisha Tedford, junior Emily Murray and sophomore Casey Henderson. Rietcheck ran in the 200- and 400-meter dashes in 30.6 seconds and 1:08.95 respectively. Tedford threw the discus 88 feet and put the shot 31 feet, 6 inches. Murray ran the 100-meter hurdles in 18.13 seconds and the 300-meter hurdles in 52.18. Henderson was in three events, running the 100-meter dash in 12.28 seconds and the 200 in 25.19, and hit 38 feet,

6 inches in the shot put. The Cowgirls scored seven points, finishing in a tie for 22nd with Andale. The Lady Panthers of Concordia won the team title with 131 points. Colby placed fifth with 42.5 points. Sophomore Lissa Mazenec led the Lady Eagles, winning the discus with a throw of 136 feet, 7 inches. Colby girls placed among the top eight in six other individual events and two relays. The Cowboys tied with Colby for 28th with two points. The Baldwin

Bulldogs won the team competition with 92 points. Sophomore Josh Baden got the two points for the Colby Eagles by running seventh in the 3,200 meters. Josef Felver, a 2004 graduate of Goodland High, ran the 100-meter dash in Saturday's college competition it in 11.96 seconds. Felver, a

sophomore at Southwestern College in Winfield, is in his second season on the Moundbuilder track team. The Cowboys and Cowgirls will be in Scott City today for a meet and travel to Holcomb for another on Friday.

Lady Trojans beat Broncbusters

The Colby Community College softball team swept the Broncbusters of Garden City Community College on the road Wednesday, winning the opener 12-1 in five innings and the nightcap 6-2. "We played very well," said Coach Carl Adams. "We had all parts of the game working. We hit the ball up and down the lineup. Our pitchers threw really well and our defense was solid."

Sophomore Amanda Bell pitched all five innings of the first game,

striking out four for the win. She is now 22-8 for the season. Sophomore Heather Ebert led the Lady Trojans at the plate, getting three hits, including a home run, scoring twice. Sophomore Jere Ebert got her 12th win of the season in the second game, pitching all seven innings and striking out two. Sophomore Molly Langarek went three for three, driving in two runs and scoring another. Colby is 34-14 for the season.

The team plays its final road games of the regular season today in Great Bend against Barton County Community College. Last Tuesday, the Trojans swept Seward County in Liberal, 7-6 and 10-3. Both Bell and Jere Ebert pitched complete games. At the Reed and Reed Invitational in Ottumwa, Iowa, April 8-9,

Colby went 3-2, beating St. Louis Community College-Meramec twice and the junior varsity of William Penn University (Iowa) once. Both losses were against Indian Hills Community College, the host team. The Trojans will finish their regular season at home, starting with Cloud County on Friday.

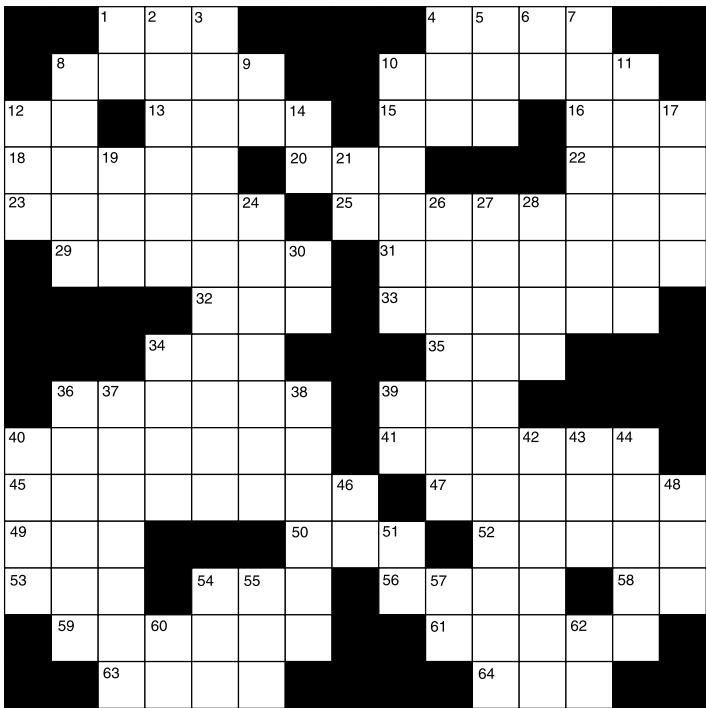
