continue doing the work needed.

Hill said there was one change to the contract dealing with collecting utility bills. He said these will be done on an contingency basis rather than an hourly basis. He said this was not discussed when the original contract was signed. These cases will pay the attorney 25 percent if collection is obtained by letter, and 30 percent if it has to go to court.

The commission gladly approved renewing the city attorney contract with Vignery and Mason.

In other business the commission:

- Approved an extension of the airport lease with Danny Barker for two months to have it expire in July when the rest of the airport leases come up for renewal.

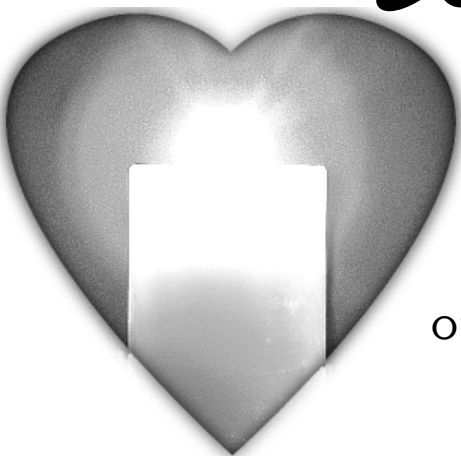
