**ORDINANCE NO. 1548**  
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER THREE, ARTICLE TWO OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF GOODLAND, KANSAS. THIS ORDINANCE PERTAINS TO THE ISSUANCE OF TEMPORARY EVENT CEREAL MALT BEVERAGE PERMITS AND ESTABLISHING REGULATIONS THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GOODLAND, KANSAS:

Section 1. That the provisions of Chapter Three, Article Two of the Code of the City of Goodland, Kansas, are hereby amended by the addition thereto of the following provisions:

## TEMPORARY EVENT CEREAL MALT BEVERAGE PERMIT

(a) Any provisions of this Chapter to the contrary notwithstanding, the City Commission may issue to a charitable or non-profit organization which is not the holder of an annual retail cereal malt beverage license, but which would otherwise qualify for such a license, a temporary event cereal malt beverage permit allowing for the sale and consumption of cereal malt beverages for limited periods of time on specifically designated premises within the City.

(b) Such permit may be issued upon a verified application filed with the City Clerk containing the following information:

- (1) The name of the fraternal or non-profit organization;
- (2) Name, address and phone number of the president and other officers of the organization;
- (3) The nature of the event or function for which the permit is requested;
- (4) The specific location(s) where the event will be conducted, which need not comply with 3-207 of the Code to the City of Goodland, Kansas, as the use herein is temporary;
- (5) The number of days or duration of the event;
- (6) Such other information as may be required.

(c) Such application shall be submitted to the City Clerk at least five (5) days prior to the city commission meeting before the event; provided, however, such time period may be waived by the Clerk when the nature and location of the event are of common knowledge to the City Commission.

(d) Each such permit shall extend for a period not to exceed seven (7) consecutive days. Not more than three (3) separate temporary event permits may be issued to any one organization during any calendar year. There must be at least a five (5) day interval between the period of the coverage for each such permit to any one organization.

(e) A temporary event permit fee of \$25.00 dollars shall accompany each permit application along with any other fees as required.

(f) All other provisions of this Chapter which are not contrary to or inconsistent with the provisions set forth in this section shall be applicable to the holder of a temporary event cereal malt beverage permit.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its publication in the official newspaper of the City of Goodland, Kansas.

## ORDINANCE NO. 1547

AN ORDINANCE ALLOWING THE CITY OF GOODLAND, KANSAS, TO ENTER INTO AN EXTENSION AGREEMENT WITH SOUTHWESTERN BELL TELEPHONE COMPANY, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ALLOWING ADDITIONAL TIME TO NEGOTIATE A NEW ORDINANCE TO BECOME EFFECTIVE ON THE EXPIRATION DATE OF THE EXISTING ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GOODLAND, KANSAS:

Section 1. The City of Goodland, Kansas, hereby declares that it deems it necessary and expedient to enter into an extension agreement with Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, for the purpose of extending the negotiating time for a new Ordinance, to become effective on the expiration date of the existing Ordinance.

Section 2. The Mayor and City Clerk of the City of Goodland, Kansas, are hereby authorized to execute an agreement of extension dated the 15th day of May 2006, between City of Goodland, Kansas and Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, and said agreement and all the provisions therein contained are hereby approved.
