Notice is hereby given that First National Bank, 202 E. 11th St., P.O. Box 570, Goodland, Kansas 67735 ("First National Bank") intends to file an application to the Comptroller of the Currency, Western District, 1225 17th Street Suite 300, Denver, CO 80202 for consent to merge The First National Bank of Mount Vernon, 109 N. Hickory, Mount Vernon, Missouri, 65712 ("Mount Vernon"), with and into First National Bank (the "Kansas Merger Application"). It is contemplated that all offices of the above named institutions will continue to operate after the completion of the merger.

Notice also is hereby given that First National Bank has filed a related application with the Comptroller of the Currency of its intent to establish a new branch at 280 Wintergreen Road, Building B, Units 8 and 9, Branson, Missouri 65616 (the "First National Bank New Branch Application").

The merger of Mount Vernon with and into First National Bank is part of a larger series of transactions by which Mid-Missouri Bank will absorb the operations of both Mount Vernon and Webb City Bank, 100 N. Main, Webb City, Missouri 64870 ("Webb City Bank"). As such, notice is hereby given that Mid-Missouri Bank, 330 West Plainview, Suite K, Springfield, Missouri 65810 ("Mid-Missouri Bank"), has made application to the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation (the "FDIC") for permission to merge with Webb City Bank. Such application is the "Mid-Missouri Merger Application." It is contemplated that all offices of the above named institutions will continue to operate after the completion of Mid-Missouri Bank's merger with Webb City Bank.

Additionally, notice is also hereby given that Mid-Missouri Bank has made application to the FDIC for written consent to purchase substantially all of the pre-merger assets and assume substantially all of the pre-merger liabilities of Mount Vernon from First National Bank, including the following three offices of First National Bank, all of which were former offices of Mount Vernon: (1) 306 Proctor Road, Greene County, Willard, Missouri 65781; (2) 109 North Hickory, Lawrence County, Mount Vernon, Missouri 65712; and (3) 200 W. Mt. Vernon Boulevard, Lawrence County, Mount Vernon, Missouri 65712. Such offices are the "Mount Vernon Offices" and the application to the FDIC is the "P&A Application." It is contemplated that all offices of the above-named institutions will continue to be operated.

These transactions discussed above are intended to facilitate (i) First National Bank in obtaining the necessary approvals to establish a branch banking facility in Missouri and (ii) Mid-Missouri Bank in consolidating the banking assets and liabilities of

Webb City Bank and Mount Vernon into Mid-Missouri Bank.

The notice for the Kansas Merger Application and the First National Bank New Branch Application is published pursuant to 12 USC 1828(c) and 12 CFR 5. The non-confidential portions of the Mid-Missouri Merger Application or the P&A Application are on file in the Regional Office and are available for public inspection during regular business hours.
