

Golfer finishes in tie for 20th

Junior Nathan Linin shot a 10-over-par 80 Monday at the state Class 4A golf championships at the Wellington Municipal Golf Course, finishing in a seven-way tie for 20th place.

"Nathan struggled off the tee," said Coach Jon McLean, "but found a way to save a lot of pars on some very tough greens. He had a great season winning three tournaments and placing in every one he played except the Hays Invitational."

Twelve teams and more than 100 players competed. Joe Ida of Fort Scott High School and Scott Glenn of Anderson County High in Garnett both shot an even-par 70. Ida won an extra-hole playoff to become the state champion. Jordan Lytton of Augusta, the defending state champion, placed third with a 71.

The Jaguars of Andover Central won the team title, led by Tyler Rody, who placed sixth with a 74, and by Alex Carney and Brent Belt, who both shot a 77 to finish in a five-way tie for 12th.

The Jaguars' team score was 298.

Hayden High of Topeka was second, scoring 315 three strokes better than third-place Fort Scott.

The Colby Eagles finished 11th, led by Chris Staley who, along with Linin, finished in a tie for 20th.

State tourney here

The Trego Community High boys of WaKeeney won the state Class 2A golf championship Monday at the Sugar Hills Golf Club in Goodland.

This was the second state title for the Golden Eagles this year; the school won the boys basketball championship in March.

Trego had three golfers place among the top 10, led by Rory Fossum, who placed fourth with a seven-over-par 78. Nathan Locke was fifth, shooting a 79, and Matt Pfannenstiel shot an 80 to place seventh.

The Eagles ended the tournament with 324, with the Tigers of St.

John-Hudson second with 334. St. Mary's-Colgan High of Pittsburg finished third with 336.

Tommy Zuzelski of Syracuse won the tournament with a three-over 74. Emmon Krusich of St. Mary's-Colgan, the defending Class 2-1A champion, was one of three players to finish the course with a 78. Krusich won an extra-hole playoff to place second with Alex Wasinger of Trinity High in Hutchinson third and Fossum fourth.

This was the first year Class 1A and 2A had separate championships. Class 3A started having its own championship in 1994.
