AN ORDINANCE ALLOWING  
THE CITY OF GOODLAND,  
KANSAS, TO ENTER INTO AN  
EXTENSION AGREEMENT  
WITH S & T COMMUNICA-  
TIONS, INC., FOR THE PUR-  
POSE OF ALLOWING ADDI-  
TIONAL TIME TO NEGOTIATE  
A NEW ORDINANCE TO BE-  
COME EFFECTIVE ON THE  
EXPIRATION DATE OF THE  
EXISTING ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE  
GOVERNING BODY OF THE  
CITY OF GOODLAND, KAN-  
SAS:

Section 1. The City of  
Goodland, Kansas, hereby de-  
clares that it deems it necessary  
and expedient to enter into an  
extension agreement with S & T  
Communications, Inc., for the  
purpose of extending the nego-  
tiating time of a new Ordinance  
to become effective on the expi-  
ration date of the existing Ordi-

**ORDINANCE NO. 1551**  
AN ORDINANCE PERTAIN-  
ING TO COURT COSTS IN THE  
MUNICIPAL COURT OF THE  
CITY OF GOODLAND, KAN-  
SAS AND REPEALING SEC-  
TION 10-104 OF THE CODE OF  
THE CITY OF GOODLAND.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE  
GOVERNING BODY OF THE  
CITY OF GOODLAND, KAN-  
SAS:

**SECTION 1.** Pursuant to  
Charter ordinance No. 12 of the  
City of Goodland, Kansas, court  
costs in the municipal court of  
the city of Goodland, Kansas are  
herby established and shall be  
assessed at the rate of \$50.00  
per case in said court; provided  
that, not more than one court  
cost shall be assessed per inci-  
dent no matter the number of  
charged violations arising from  
said incident.

**SECTION 2.** All court costs  
collected by the municipal court  
or the clerk of the court shall be  
paid as follows:

A. During the period com-  
mencing July 1, 1994 and end-  
ing June 30, 1996, \$1.00 to the  
local law enforcement training  
reimbursement fund estab-  
lished pursuant to K.S.A. 74-  
5620 and amendments thereto,  
\$4.00 to the law enforcement  
training center fund established  
pursuant to K.S.A. 74-5619 and  
amendments thereto, \$0.50 to

the protection from abuse fund  
established pursuant to K.S.A.  
74-7325 and amendments  
thereto and \$0.50 to the crime  
victims assistance fund estab-  
lished pursuant to K.S.A. 74-  
7334 and amendments thereto.

B. During the period com-  
mencing July 1, 1996 and end-  
ing June 30, 1997, \$1.00 to the  
local law enforcement training  
reimbursement fund estab-  
lished pursuant to K.S.A. 74-  
5620 and amendments thereto,  
\$4.00 to the law enforcement  
training center fund established  
pursuant to K.S.A. 74-5619 and  
amendments thereto.C. On or  
after July 1, 1997, \$1.00 to the  
local law enforcement training  
reimbursement fund estab-  
lished pursuant to K.S.A. 74-  
5620 and amendments thereto,  
\$2.00 to the law enforcement  
training center fund established  
pursuant to K.S.A. 74-5619 and  
amendments thereto, \$2.00 to  
the juvenile detention facilities  
fund established pursuant to  
K.S.A. 79-4803 and amend-  
ments thereto to be expended  
for the operational cost of facili-  
ties for the detention of juveniles.

D. Fifty cents as judicial  
branch education fees to the  
State of Kansas pursuant to  
K.S.A. 12-4114, 12-4115, and  
12-4116 as amended and Kan-  
sas Supreme Court 91SC1 and  
1992 HB2832E

E. On or after July 1, 1999  
\$1.00 to the trauma fund estab-  
lished by Section 8 of K.S.A. 12-  
4117 as amended and found in  
the 1999 Supplement to the  
Kansas Statutes Annotated.  
This section applies only when  
the defendant paying said court  
costs is adjudged guilty of a mov-  
ing violation under section  
K.S.A. 8-2118.

F. On or after July 1, 2006,  
\$1.00 to the local law enforce-  
ment training reimbursement  
fund established pursuant to  
K.S.A. 74-5620 and amend-

ments thereto, \$11.50 to the law  
enforcement training center  
fund established pursuant to  
K.S.A. 74-5619 and amend-  
ments thereto, \$2.50 to the Kan-  
sas Commission on peace  
Officer's standards and training  
fund established by K.S.A. 74-  
5619 and amendments thereto,  
\$2.00 to the juvenile detention  
facilities established pursuant to  
K.S.A. 79-4803 and amend-  
ments thereto to be expended  
for the operational cost of facili-  
ties for the detention of juveniles,  
\$0.50 to the protection from  
abuse fund established pursu-  
ant to K.S.A. 74-7325 and  
amendments thereto, \$0.50 to  
the crime victims assistance  
fund established pursuant to  
K.S.A. 74-7334 and amend-  
ments thereto, and \$1.00 to the  
trauma fund established pursu-  
ant to K.S.A. 2005 Supp. 75-  
5670 and amendments thereto.

**SECTION 3.** All monies re-  
maining in the hands of the mu-  
nicipal court or the clerk of the  
court after the payments as set  
out in Section 2 shall be paid to  
into the general fund of the city.

**SECTION 4.** Section 10-104  
of the Code of the City of  
Goodland is hereby repealed.

**SECTION 5.** This Ordinance  
shall take effect and be in force  
from and after its publication in  
the official City newspaper.
