The Goodland Elks K-18 is in full swing with a 3-1 record. The team traveled to Colby on Monday to face Colby's second team and winning 17-7.

"Cameron Morris pitched a superb game striking out nine out of the 25 batters he challenged," said scorekeeper Traci Waugh. "The team played an excellent game with a beautiful double play, only one error and 44 total at-bats."

The team is made up of 17, 13 to 15 year-old players with Gary Smith, veterinarian from Prairieland Animal Clinic, coaching and Rod Kling, farmer, and Steve Duell, farmer assisting.

Returning players for the team are Cameron Morris, Rory Kling, Adam Duell, Keagen Smith, Kevin Amthor and Ben Waugh.

The first game the team played against Colby at Memorial Field was called due to inclement weather

in the top of the second inning. That game has been rescheduled for Monday, July 17 at Memorial Field.

Oakley came to Memorial Field on Thursday, June 15, and was defeated 17-7. Brandon Rome started as the pitcher with Cameron Morris relieving. The players played five innings with 34 at-bats and one error.
