The Goodland swim team went to Burlington Saturday to compete in the swim meet there. This Saturday the team will compete in Oakley. Goodland swimmers finished first in six events. Two swimmers won first in two individual events. Riley Oharah took first in the 11-12 boys 50-yard freestyle (29.13) and 50-yard breaststoke (42.53) and Holton Witman took the 9-10 boys 25-yard freestyle (15.54) and 25-yard backstroke (22.40). Brennan Clouse won first in 100-yard backstroke (1:18.25). The 8-and-undermixed 100-yard medley relay crew, Sianna Miller, Drew House, Kelsey White and Alex Goodwin, finished first with 1:59.62.

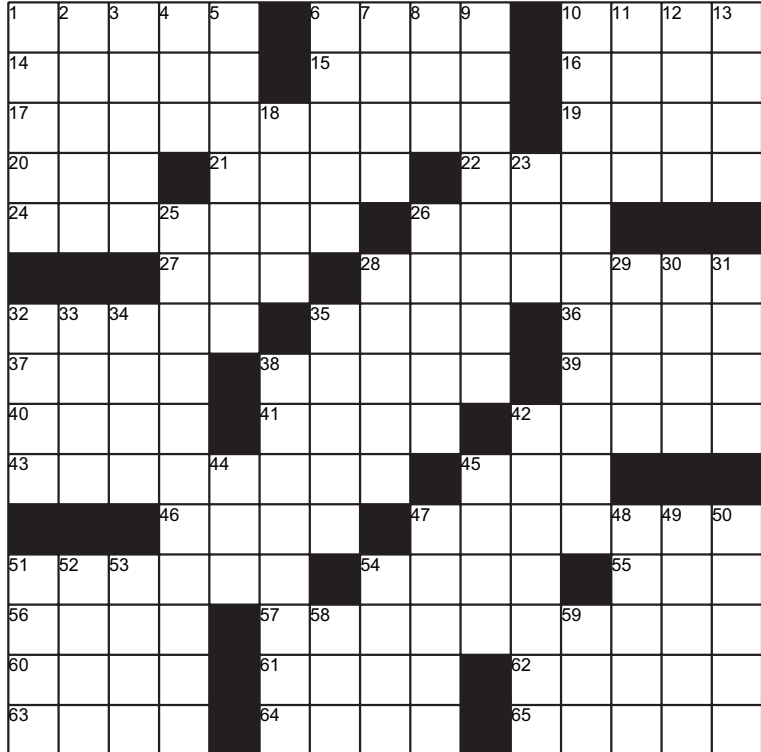
