Early blight (caused by alternaria) and septoria leaf spot are two tomato diseases that tend to pop up in June. Both of the disease-causing fungi survive the winter on infected plant debris, and they can be introduced on infected transplants and seeds.

These fungi tend to get established on the lower, inner leaves first. Septoria leaf spot is characterized by abundant small (about 1/8 inch) gray circular spots with dark borders. Sometimes you can see little black dots in the lesions.

Early blight causes larger lesions that are dark brown or gray with many concentric darker rings, like a target. The two can occur on the same plant, and both can cause de- ther improve airflow.
