The K-State Wildcats opened practice Saturday in front of the Vanier Sports Complex (top), which is being renovated. Head Coach Ron Prince (far left) worked with the receivers, and is looking for a good year. Jordan Bedore, a Goodland High School graduate, is in his third year, and is one of three former Cowboys on the K-State squad.

A 2004 graduate of Goodland High, he is the son of Dustin and Barb Bedore of Brewster.

Senior tight end Donald Raymer begins his second season at Kansas State after playing two seasons at Garden City Community College.

He is the son of Steve and Debra Raymer of Goodland and a 2003 graduate of Goodland High.

Joining the Wildcats this year is Brandon Cowan, who graduated from Goodland High in 2005. He is the son of Brad and Kris Cowan.

The 'Cats will play Illinois State University on Sept. 2, in their first home game at the Bill Snyder Family Stadium.

K-State will play each Saturday through Nov. 18, opening with four straight home games against nonconference opponents. After Illinois State, the Wildcats play Florida Atlantic University, Marshall University (W.Va.) then the University of Louisville.

The 'Cats begin conference play Sept. 30 at Baylor, followed by home games against Oklahoma State and Nebraska. The Wildcats will close the regular season with their annual showdown against the Kansas Jayhawks in Lawrence on Nov. 18.

Atwood wins golf tournament

In the tournament, each team competes with their 11 best available golfers and all play

scratch golf. The top 10 scores are used to determine the winner, said Kay Melia, tournament director.

Marcus Grinnan of Burlington won medalist honors with a three-under-par 68.

Colby Country Club did not field a full team, but Scott Focke shot a 70 for runner up honors. Focke tied the course record of 30 on the front nine.

Tyson Shelley of Goodland shot a par 71. Other outstanding individual scores were Michael Terry of Atwood with a 73; Kevin Finley of

Atwood, Rollie Halligan of Goodland and John Penny of Burlington all with 74; and Dick Ahlberg of Oberlin, Jon McLean of Goodland and Kenney Rummel of Atwood at 75.

Hoxie did not field a full team, and the Benkelman Country Club did not compete due to prior commitments.
