

Drivers win track titles at county speedway

Racing is not quite over at the Sherman County Speedway, but the track champions for this season were figured up after the races on Sept. 2.

The final races of the year will be the 17th annual Flatlander Fall Classic on Friday and Saturday, Sept. 22-23, but the races last week were the last that counted for the season championships.

Jacob Long (71) of Burlington was named track champion in the mini-stock division by one point (315 points) over Brian Kleine (1) of Burlington (314).

Long won his fourth main event with Kleine a close second. Kleine had been leading the points race until the Bill Gray Memorial on Saturday, Aug. 19, when Long won his third main event of the year to tie Kleine in the points race.

Tyrell Smith (12) of Goodland finished third in the main event on Sept. 2, and finished third in the point standings. Cassandra Dawdy (77) of Goodland was sixth in the

main event and finished 10th in the point standings.

In the econo division, where all the drivers are from Goodland, Roger Snethen (\$5) won the main event and sewed up the track championship with 301 points over Justin Colby, who was second with 260, but did not run in the main event on Sept. 2.

Diann Ross (81) finished fourth in the main event, and was 14th in the point standings with 111. Adrienne West (7) was ninth and finished 10th in the point standings with 128.

Lee Hageman (4) was second in the main event, and finished fourth in the points race with 250.

Dusty Knox was third in the main event, and 15th in the point standings with 74.

Jeremy Blackwell (25) of Gem won his fifth straight main event in the bomber class and outdistanced his competition in the points race for the track championship with 318 points.

Joey Snethen (\$98) of Goodland was fourth in the main event, and tied for second in the point standings with 268.

Adam Morris (8) of Lamar, Colo., was second, and ninth in the point standings with 111.

Matt Morris (21M) of Lamar, was third in the main and seventh in the point standings with 119.

Steve Arntt (12) of Goodland was ninth in the main, and tied for second in the point standings with 268.

Tyler Henderson (7T) of Goodland was 10th in the main, and sixth in the point standings with 207.

In the stock class, Randy Tipton (9) of Weskan took the track championship, winning his third straight main event to finish with 257 points.

Brad Wagoner (15) of Colby was second in the stock main and 12th in the point standings with 29. Tom Nelson (30) of Aurora, Colo., was third, and was third in the points standing with 181.

Jason Stevens (77) of Colby was fourth in the main and second in points with 217.

Darren DeLoach (21) of Lamar was the track champion in the modified class, but finished third in the main event behind Doug

Holzmetiser (34H) of Colby and Will Brack (15W) of Meade, Colo. DeLoach won the track title with 295 points with Jeff Tubbs (37) of Colby second with 279. Tubbs was ninth in the main event.

Keith Stegman (19) of Lamar

was 11th in the main, and third in the points with 267. Brady (3) of Holly, Colo. was fourth in the points with 266, but finished 20th in the main.

Brack, who finished second in the main was 21st in the standings with 78.

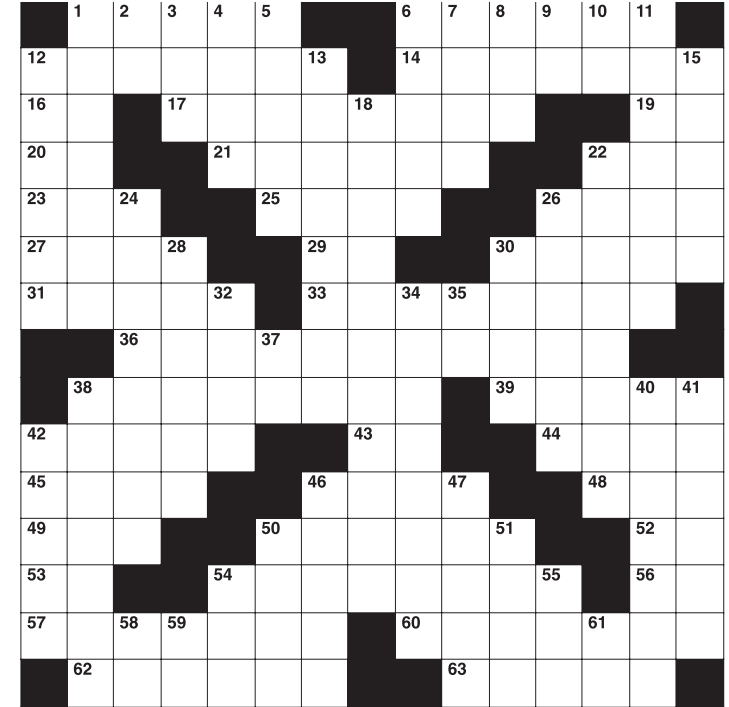
