Today, the pledge reads: "I pledge my Head to clearer thinking, my Heart to greater loyalty, my Hands to larger service and my Health to better living, for my club, my community, my country and my world."

With songs about stinky feet, scabs and already-chewed gum, he creates a combination that will not only trigger most kids' "gross" meters but leave them giggling.

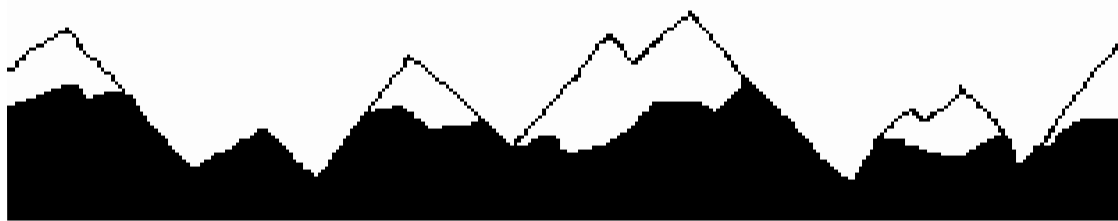
Although he has won two National Parents' Choice Awards and

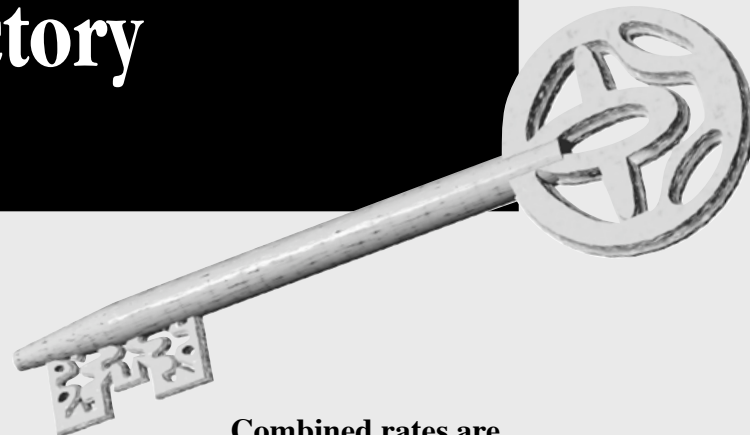

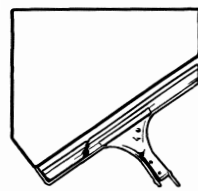
