AN ORDINANCE ALLOWING THE CITY OF GOODLAND, KANSAS, TO ENTER INTO AN INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT WITH SHERMAN COUNTY, KANSAS, RESPECTING STREET AND ROAD IMPROVEMENTS IN SHERMAN COUNTY, KANSAS AND THE CITY OF GOODLAND, KANSAS AND THE FINANCING THEREOF

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GOODLAND, KANSAS:

Section 1. The City of Goodland, Kansas, hereby declares that it deems it necessary and expedient to enter into an interlocal cooperation agreement with Sherman County, Kansas, respecting street and road improvements in Sherman County, Kansas and the City of

Goodland, Kansas and financing thereof.

Section 2. The Mayor and City Clerk of the City of Goodland, Kansas, are hereby authorized to execute an agreement of interlocal cooperation dated the 15TH day of September, 2006 between Sherman County, Kansas and the City of Goodland, Kansas, and said agreement and all the provisions therein contained are hereby approved.

RESOLUTION NO. 06-12

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE FORM OF AND AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF AN INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT RESPECTING STREET AND ROAD IMPROVEMENTS IN SHERMAN COUNTY, KANSAS AND THE CITY OF GOODLAND, KANSAS AND THE FINANCING THEREOF.

WHEREAS, K.S.A. 12-2901 et seq. (the "Act") provides that in order for public agencies to make the most efficient use of their powers, such public agencies may cooperate with other public agencies on a basis of mutual advantage to provide services and facilities in a manner that will best accord with geographic, economic and other factors influencing the needs and development of such public agencies; and

WHEREAS, the Act authorizes public agencies to enter into interlocal agreements with one or more other public agencies for joint or cooperative action pursuant to the provisions of the Act; and

WHEREAS, Sherman County, Kansas (the "County") is a public agency within the State of Kansas (the "State") and, pursuant to the Act, it is necessary and advisable to enter into an interlocal agreement with the City of Goodland, Kansas (the "City"), whereby the County will pay costs to construct certain street and road improvements in the County and City (the "Project") by the issuance of general obligation sales tax bonds of the County, and the County and City agree to follow certain procedures respecting the payment of Project costs and the repayment of the principal of and interest on such bonds.

WHEREAS, Sherman County, Kansas (the "County") is a public agency within the State of Kansas (the "State") and, pursuant to the Act, it is necessary and advisable to enter into an interlocal agreement with the City of Goodland, Kansas (the "City"), whereby the County will pay costs to construct certain street and road improvements in the County and City (the "Project") by the issuance of general obligation sales tax bonds of the County, and the County and City agree to follow certain procedures respecting the payment of Project costs and the repayment of the principal of and interest on such bonds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY SHERMAN COUNTY, KANSAS, AS FOLLOWS:

COUNTY, KANSAS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The County is hereby authorized to enter into an "Interlocal Cooperation Agreement Respecting Street and Road Improvements in Sherman County, Kansas and the City of Goodland, Kansas and the Financing Thereof" (the "Agreement") with the City in substantially the form attached hereto as **Exhibit A**, with such minor changes as may be approved by the County's legal counsel. The Chairman and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute the agreement in a form approved by the County's legal counsel, such execution being conclusive evidence of such approval.

SECTION 2. The Clerk is hereby further authorized and directed to forward a copy of this Resolution and the Agreement, executed by the governing body of the County, to the City Clerk.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall be in force and take effect from and after its adoption by the governing body of the County.
