SECTION 1. The County is hereby authorized to enter into an "Interlocal Cooperation Agreement Respecting Street and Road Improvements in Sherman County, Kansas and the City of Goodland, Kansas and the Financing Thereof' (the "Agreement") with the City in substantially the form attached hereto as *Exhibit A*, with such minor changes as may be approved by the County's legal counsel. SECTION 2. The Clerk is hereby further authorized and directed to forward a copy of this Resolution and the Agreement, executed by the governing, body of the County, to the City Clerk.




